




The memorandum of cooperation was signed and project of State Final Examination Format development was discussed. Trial State Final Examination took place: it was a necessary step of future exam development.








What is reading?

Reading skill development include the ability to comprehend and use both listening and speaking skills because you need to:

- Hear a word before you can say it
 - Say a word before you can read it
- Read a word before you can write it

Beginning reading

- Begin reading only after acquiring some basic knowledge of the spoken language.
- 2. Learning new alphabet should begin with learning single letters, starting with the most common and useful (phonic method)






Beginning reading

- 3. Names of letters is less useful for reading. With young learners - first sounds, then letters.
- 4. Teach lower and upper cases together.
