



Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

- виражає одноразову або постійну дію в майбутньому:

I will see Andrew tonight.

He will work at the bank next month.

- виражає рішення, пропозиції, обіцянки, прохання, передбачення:

We will come back soon.

Shall I make you coffee?

Future Simple Tense

shall

- використовується у першій особі однини і множини: I / we для утворення майбутнього часу та для пропозицій:

I shall watch TV tonight.

We shall go to the hospital tomorrow.

Shall we go to the cinema tonight?

З 1950 року в сучасній англійській мові, особливо в американському варіанті форма *shall* використовується дуже рідко. Її замінила форма *will*.

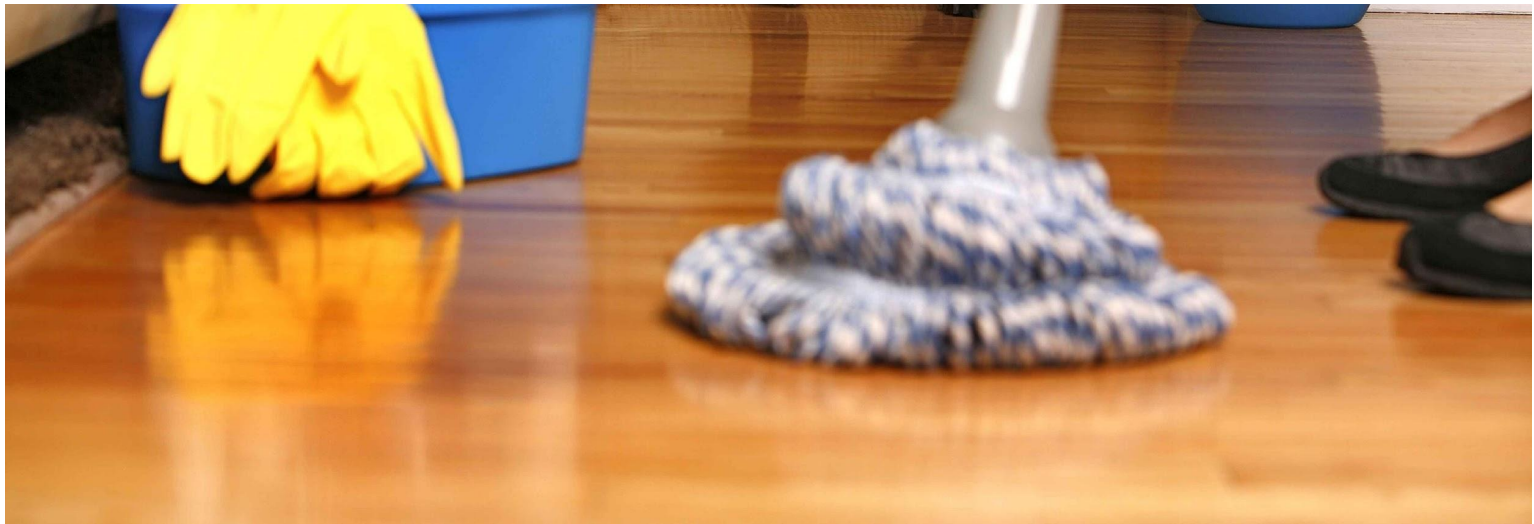

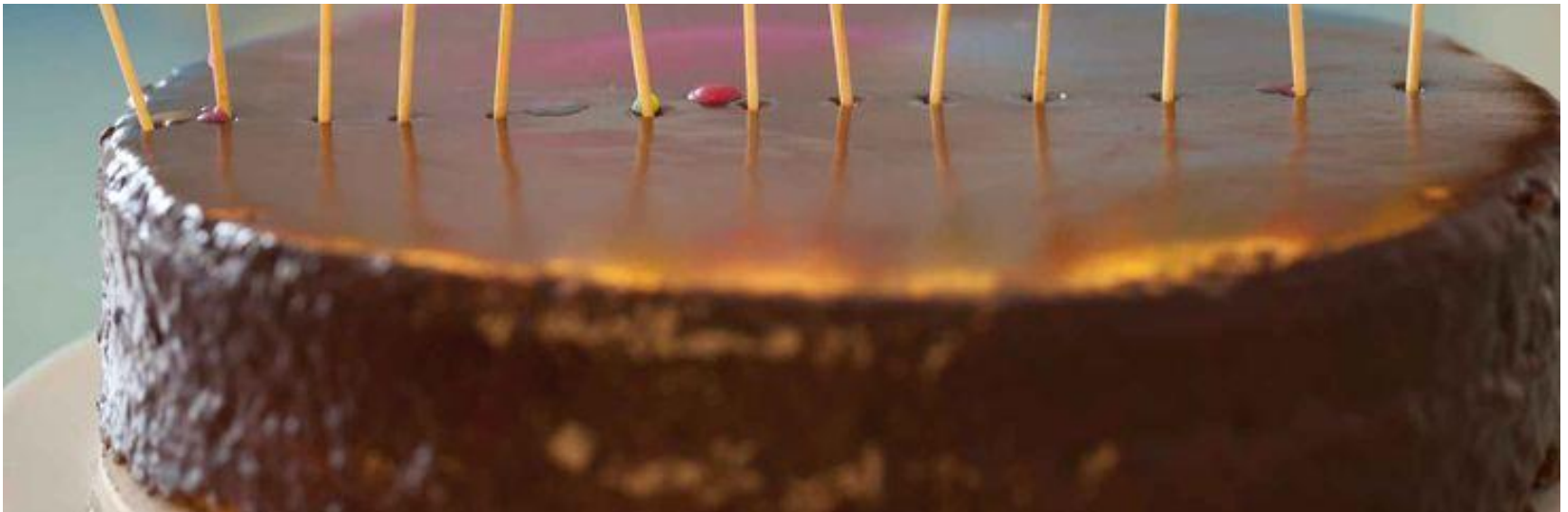

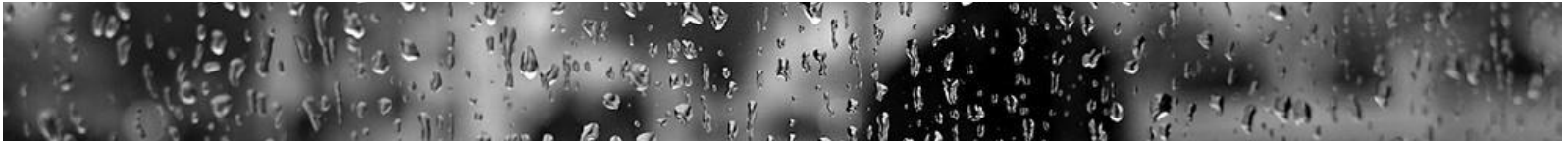

Future Continuous Tense

- the whole day
- from 3 to 5 p.m.
- when

He will be closing his shop at the afternoon every day.

Future Perfect Tense

The film will have finished by 10 p.m.

- виражає дію, що відбудуватиметься до початку іншої дії в майбутньому:
I will have cleaned the room before you come.
