

Political System of Great Britain

- *Power in the country belongs to Parliament.
- *The British Parliament consists of the House of Lords and the House of Commons.
- *The House of Commons consists of Members of Parliament.



Political System of Great Britain


The functions of the House of Commons are legislation and scrutiny of government activities. The leader of the party which obtains a majority of seats in a general election is named Prime Minister and is formally asked by the Sovereign to recommend a group of Ministers to form a Government. The position of Prime Minister is based on convention, not statute.





Economy of Great Britain.

Unlike the United States, where the financial sector is smaller as a share of GDP, the UK economy has still not recovered the output lost in the post-2008 Great Recession, owing to continued retrenchment in the banking sector. The facts are clear: the UK's economy, security, and international stature all benefit from EU membership.



About economy:

Speaking about the economy of Great Britain it should be mentioned that as in many other countries the economy of Britain is based mostly on

private enterprises. Different services and manufacturing are well developed, while the agriculture does not take the leading place here. Britain has the possibility to use oil and natural gas from the North Sea and this makes the country self-sufficient in energy. More than half of domestic oil production Britain exports to other countries.




