- 1979 the idea of the Handbook that anyone can write (Douglas Adams, "the Hitchhiker's guide to the Galaxy")
- 1993 first electronic encyclopedia (MS Encarta).
- 1999 the idea of a free universal encyclopedia (Richard Stallman).





Wikipedia is not an indiscriminate






