- It's on the left/right.

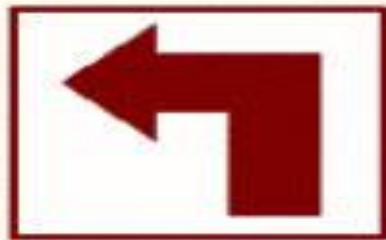
