

# MUSEUM OF THE HUMAN BODY

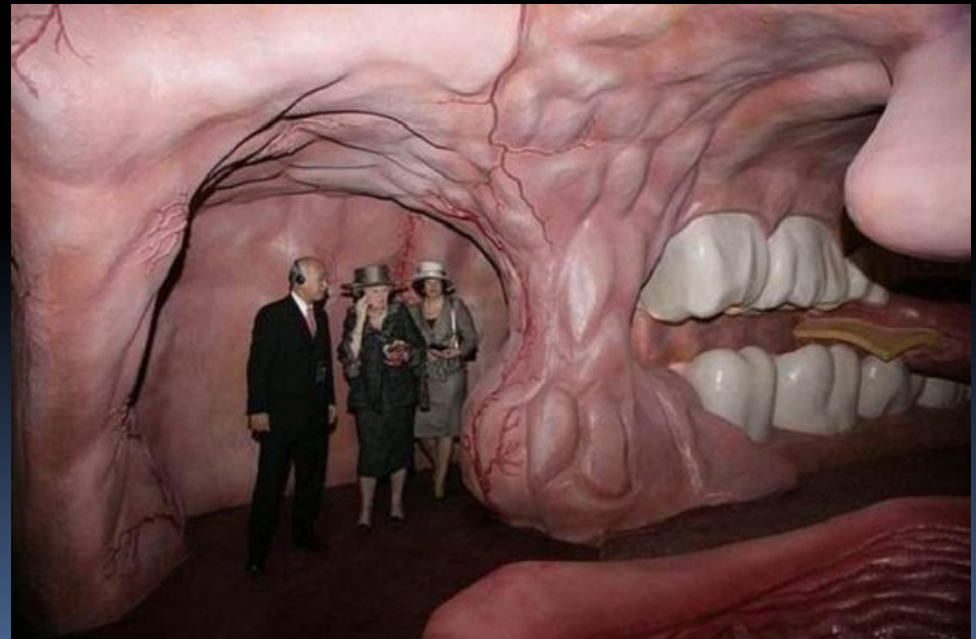
Museum **Corpus** of the human body in the Dutch town of Oegstgeest (Oegstgeest) was opened in 2008 . At its creation took almost 12 years of mental labor ( the actual construction began in late 2006 - early 2007 ) and \$ 27 million . Of course , **Corpus** was created for educational purposes. But his inspirer Henri Remmers (Henri Remmers), general manager of the company Reco Productions International, did not want to just tell people how and what is happening in our body , but also to show the impact on the " sound mind " diet and exercise .



First you get a giant in the knee , and from there go on the path around the body , and end the tour in the brain . This effect lasts for about an hour . Just want to note that there are audio guides in many languages , including Russian language.



In addition to the work of our bodies , you will also learn how to form red blood cells ; as the body releases antibodies , if the body has got a splinter ; what happens when people sneeze when asleep , when an injury , etc.



■ Slowly climbing up the escalators and moving platforms to help visitors move past the internal organs, or through them, where they see an enlarged size muscles, bones, heart, kidneys, lungs, digestive organs, eyes, ears and brain.



The next stage - the inner ear and nasal cavity, in which the visitors demonstrated sneezing process. Next - the interior of the eyeball, where adults and children tell how the light falls on the retina as formed and transmitted to the brain image. And, of course, the main control center of the body - the brain.

■ The movement by groups of internal organs or even through it is accompanied by a variety of effects , such as audio , copy the body's natural sounds. However, they are not always natural , for example the movement of sperm cells is accompanied by the tramp of a herd of horses .

Admission "inside man" is set at 16.50 euros for adults and 14 euros for children , group discounts are possible . The museum is open daily except Monday from 09:30 until the last tour , which ends at 17:00 .

- My favorite exhibit is the room where we consider the digestive system , lungs and heart . The " mouth " show visitors the work of the vocal cords and the taste buds





# museum address

- The most convenient way to get to the museum from Amsterdam on a personal or rented car. The trip takes less than 40 minutes, to the same museum Corpusmeent own parking. Leave your car there for 4 hours costs € 6. From Amsterdam Central Station you can reach LeidenCentraal station, then sit down in Leiden on 30, 31 or 38 bus routes which pass by the museum. By public transport you will reach the Corpus hour. If you are staying in Leiden, you will be more comfortable to sit on the 37 bus, which stops exactly at the museum of the human body.
