- 200 states are incorporated in global terror



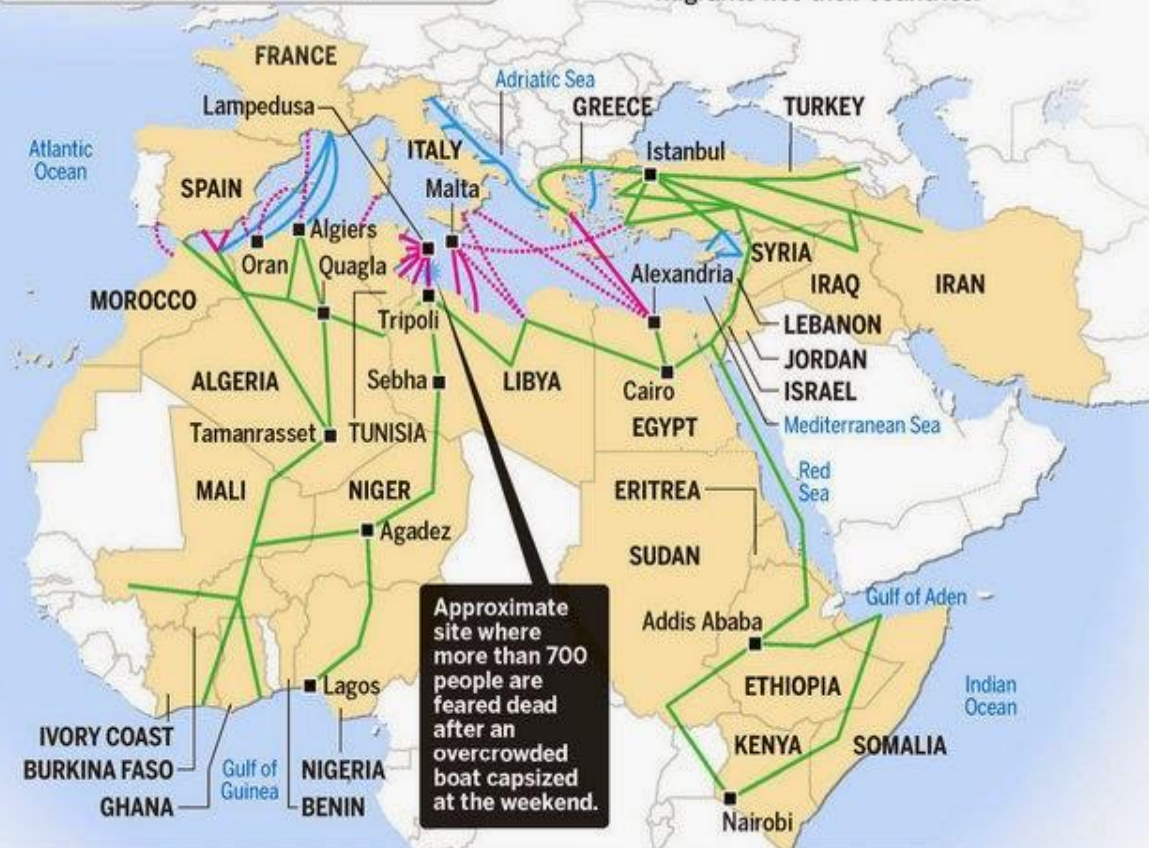
UBIQUITOUSNESS OF MIGRATION FLOWS

Deadly voyage

Packed into rickety vessels by people smugglers, the path desperate migrants take to reach Europe across the Mediterranean is a dangerous one. Here is a look at the routes they take, the numbers of those who have made it and who have died on the way, and reasons why the migrants flee their countries.

- Major maritime routes
- Minor maritime routes
- Ferry routes
- Major land routes



- About 2 million application of asylum

- About 5000 deaths while crossing the borders

THE UNHOLY NEXUS

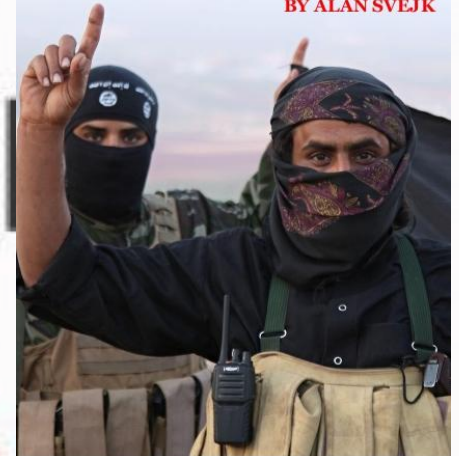


INEFFICACY OF BORDER CONTROL

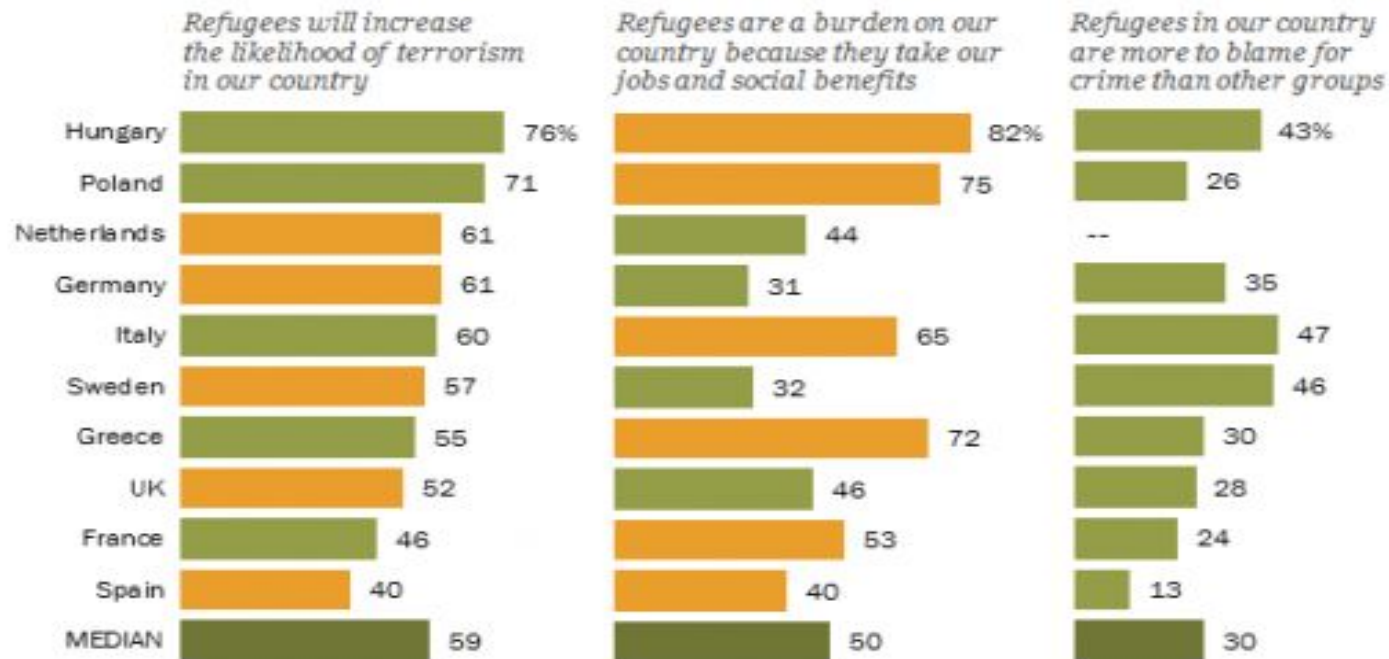
- The rise of aggression towards native citizens
