- *Oxford is an independent and self-governing institution, consisting of the central University and the Colleges.*

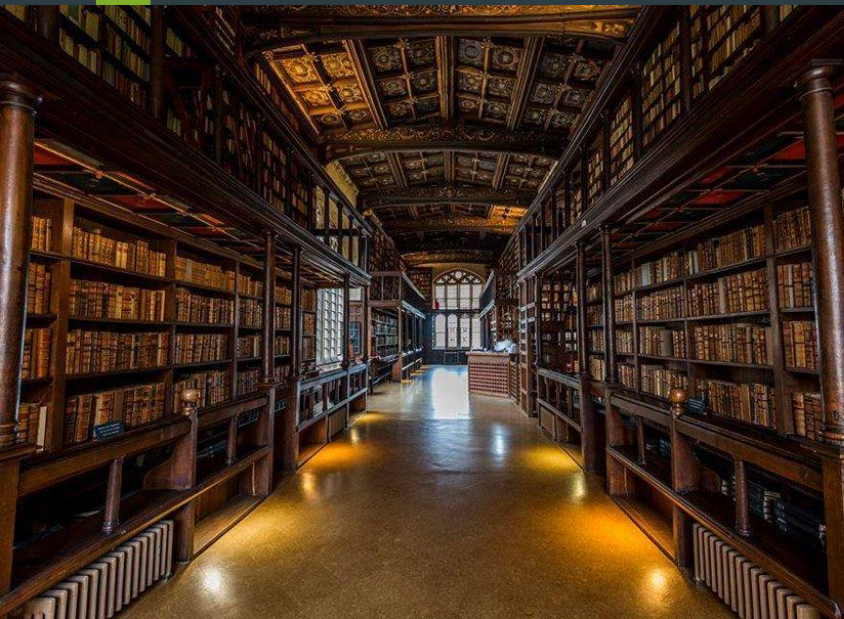


Education

- *Full academic dress is worn at examinations*

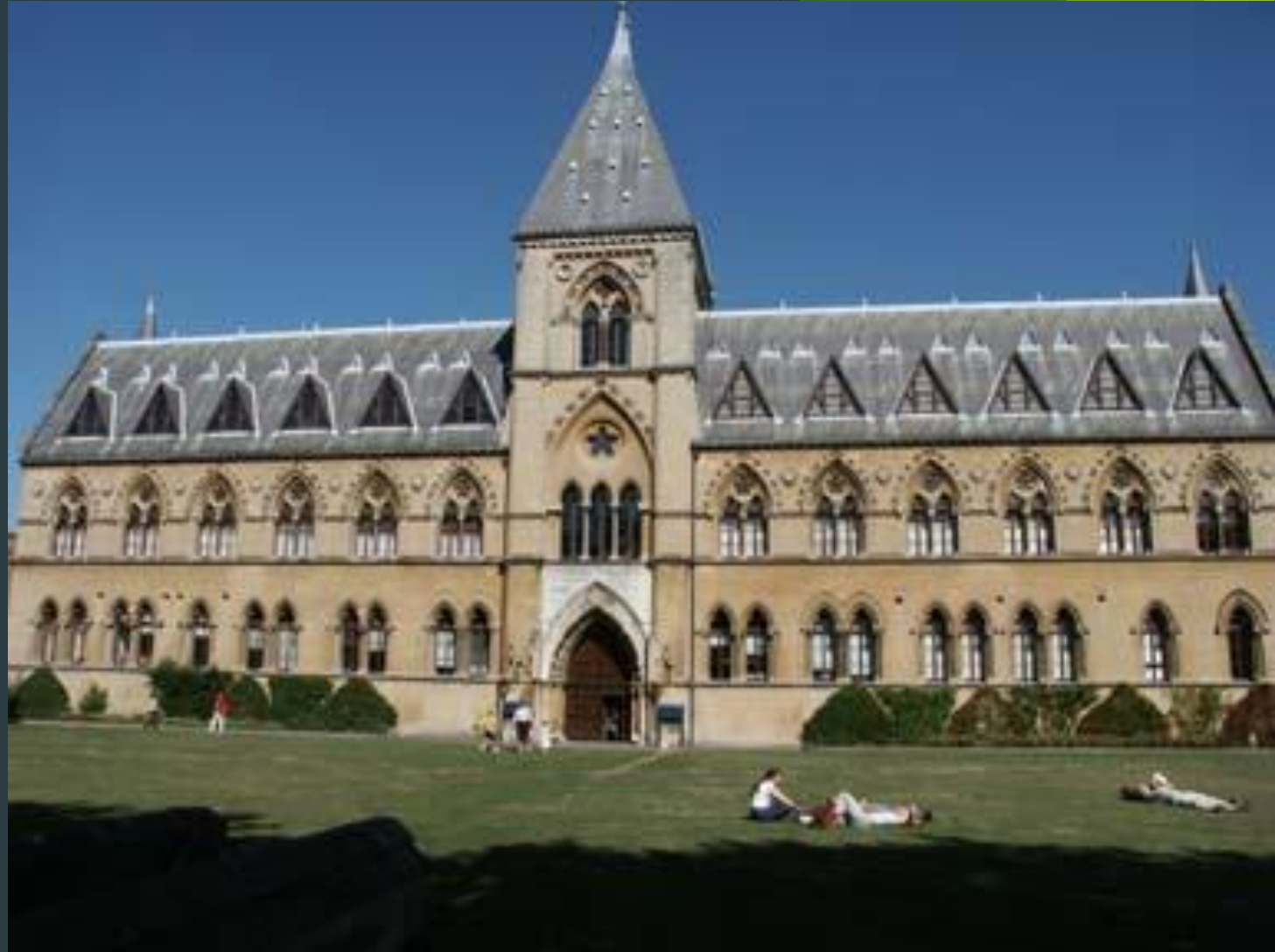
Bodleian library
