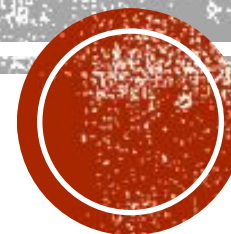


DIFFERENT TYPES OF CRIMES

WHAT IS CRIME?

An action or omission:

- which constitutes an offence
- and is punishable by law
- defined by criminal law
- If one engages in such behavior, they may be guilty of a crime and prosecuted in criminal court



MAJOR CATEGORIES

- personal crimes
- property crimes
- inchoate crimes
- Statutory Crimes



PERSONAL CRIMES

- Assault
- Battery
- False Imprisonment
- Kidnapping
- Homicide
- Rape, statutory rape, sexual assault and other offenses of a sexual nature



PROPERTY CRIMES

- Larceny (theft)
- Robbery (theft by force)
- Burglary (penalties for burglary)
- Arson
- Embezzlement
- Forgery
- False pretenses
- Receipt of stolen goods



INCHOATE CRIMES

- Attempt – any crime that is attempted like “attempted robbery”
- Solicitation
- Conspiracy



STATUTORY CRIMES

- Alcohol-related crimes such as drunk driving (DUI)
- Selling alcohol to a minor.



DIFFERENT LEVELS OF SERIOUSNESS FOR DIFFERENT CRIMES

- Felony
- Misdemeanor



TYPES BY CRIMINAL INTENT

- For example:
- General Intent Crimes
- Specific Intent Crimes



VOCABULARY

- Assault – нападение, страх перед причинением вреда
- Battery – нападение, физическое
- Larceny – воровство
- Burglary - взлом
- Arson - поджог
- Embezzlement - казнокрадство
- Forgery – подделывание чего-либо
- Solicitation - вымогательство
