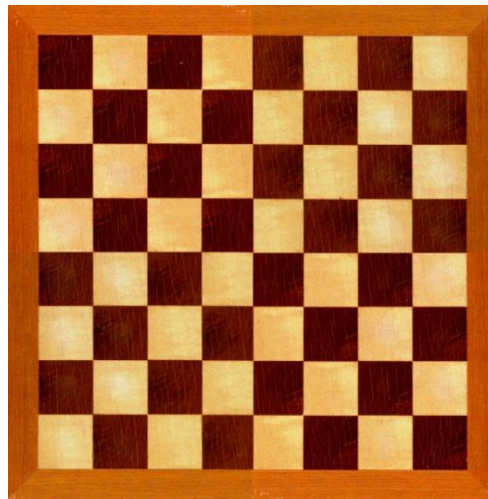


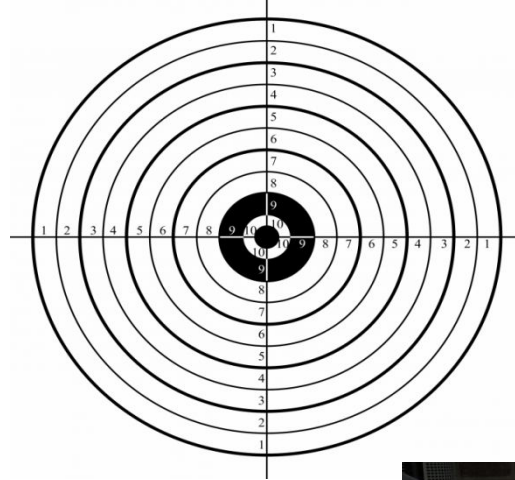
French sociologist Roger Caillois, in his book "Games and Men", defined a game as an activity that must have the following characteristics:
