

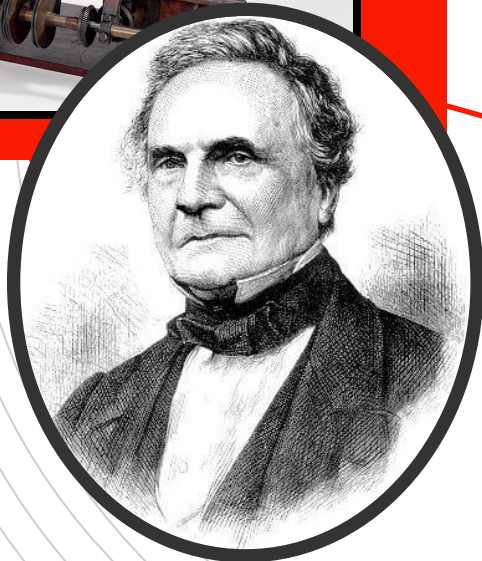
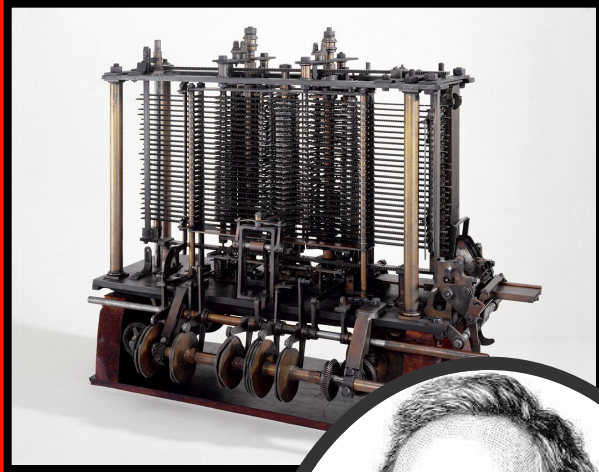

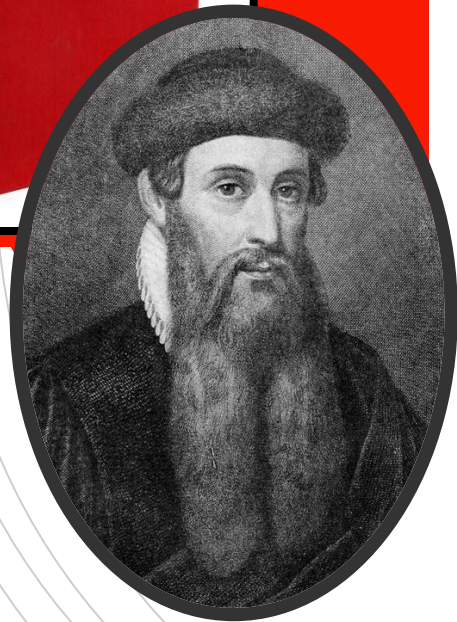
## Computer

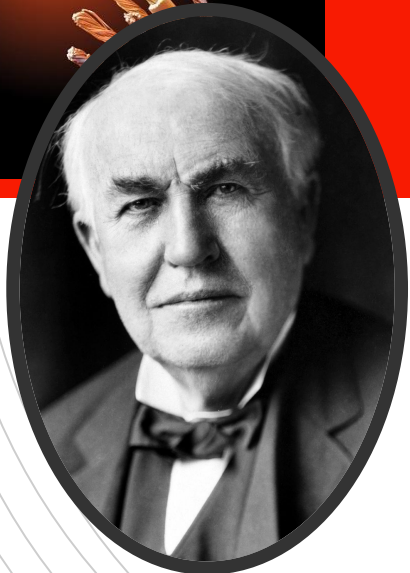
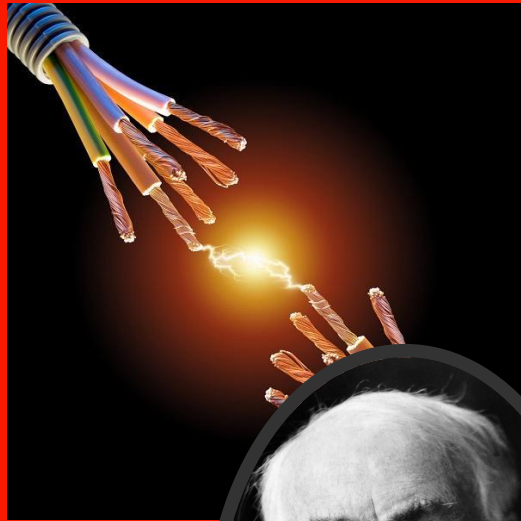


## Books

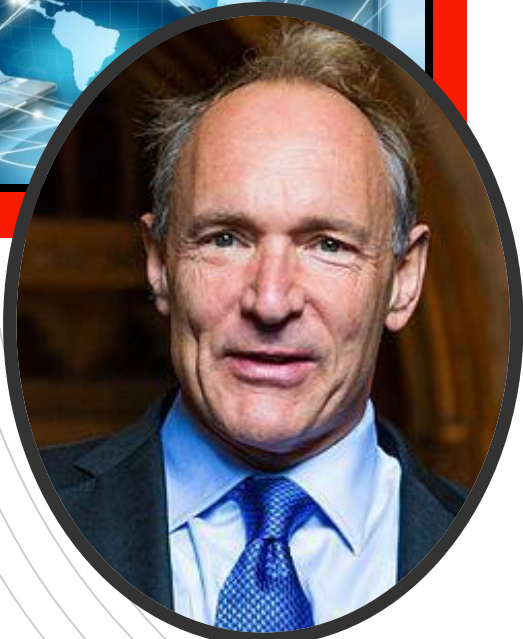
## Cinema
