be going to

She is going to have her eyes tested. — Она собирается проверить зрение. (пойдет в офтальмологический центр, где ее зрение проверит окули

Present Perfect:

I haven't had the film developed yet. — я еще не проявил фотопленку. (другими словами, не отнес ее на проявку в фото-центр)

Past Simple:

I <u>had</u> the new dress <u>made</u>. – Я пошила новое платье. (пошили в ателье, а не я

Where did you <u>have</u> your watch repaired? — где ты отремонтировала часы? (в какую мастерскую ты их носила)

Why didn't you have your fur-coat cleaned? — почему ты не почистила свою шубу? (не отнесла ее в химчистку)

Past Continuous:

They were having their new house decorated at that moment – они декорировали свой дом в тот момент. (группа рабочих выполняла отделку, а не сами хозяева)

Present Perfect Continuous:

I have been having my sight tested for an hour already. — Я уже час проверяю зрение. (не сама, врач его оценивает)

Past Perfect:

My mother had had her fence painted by the end of the week. — К концу недели мама покрасила забор. (красила не она сама, а наемные рабочие)

Future Simple:

She <u>will have</u> her new book <u>published</u>. – Она выпустит свою новую книгу. (выпустит издательство, а не сама автор)


