# have something done

*Present Simple:*

**Every Friday Joe has his car**

**washed.** – *Каждую пятницу Джо моет свою машину. (но моет не сам собственноручно, а отгоняет на мойку)*



*Present Continuous:*

**I am having a swimming**

**pool built now. — Я сейчас**

**строю бассейн. (группа рабочих**

**занимается этим, а не я**

**самостоятельно)**



# be going to

*She is going to have her eyes tested.* – Она собирается проверить зрение. (пойдет в офтальмологический центр, где ее зрение проверит окули



Present Perfect:

**I haven't had the film**

**developed yet.** — Я еще не проявил фотопленку. (другими словами, не отнес ее на проявку в фото-центр)

## ***Past Simple:***

**I had the new dress made.** – Я пошила новое платье. (пошили в ателье, а не я сама)

**Where did you have your watch repaired?** — Где ты отремонтировала часы? (в какую мастерскую ты их носила)

**Why didn't you have your fur-coat cleaned?** — Почему ты не почистила свою шубу? (не отнесла ее в химчистку)

Past Continuous:

They were having their new house decorated at that moment. – Они декорировали свой дом в тот момент. (группа рабочих выполняла отделку, а не сами хозяева)



### **Present Perfect Continuous:**

I have been having my sight tested for an hour already. – Я уже час проверяю зрение. (не сама, врач его оценивает)

### **Past Perfect:**

My mother had had her fence painted by the end of the week. – К концу недели мама покрасила забор. (красила не она сама, а наемные рабочие)



Future Simple:

She will have her new book published. – Она выпустит свою новую книгу. (выпустит издательство, а не сама автор)
