Early Life

- Was of african descent
- Born into upper class literary family
- Actual mother took little interest in him, so had nurses / French tutors





Early Life

- Loved his nanny Arina Rodionovna
- ➤ Entered an elite school called the Lyceum at the age of 12
- ➤ Began working in the foreign office of St. Petersburg, Russia

Education

- ➤ Entered the Lyceum in 1811 which was only open for the sons of 'select' noblemen
- ➤ Graduated from the Lyceum in 1817
- ➤ Taught by the great poet Vasily Zhukovsky

Writing Style

- Russian poet, novelist, playwright of the Romantic era
- Pushkin's work in short stories shows simplicity, versatility and clarity
- ➤ In short stories showed satire, romance, and drama which later influenced Russian writers

Death

By 1837, Pushkin was falling into greater and greater debt and faced scandalous rumors that his wife had embarked on a love affair.

In response, the poet challenged Natalya's alleged lover, her brother in-law Georges d'Anthès, to a duel which left both men injured.

Shot in the right lower abdomen, Pushkin died two days later.
