Canadian police officers are famous for their bright outfit



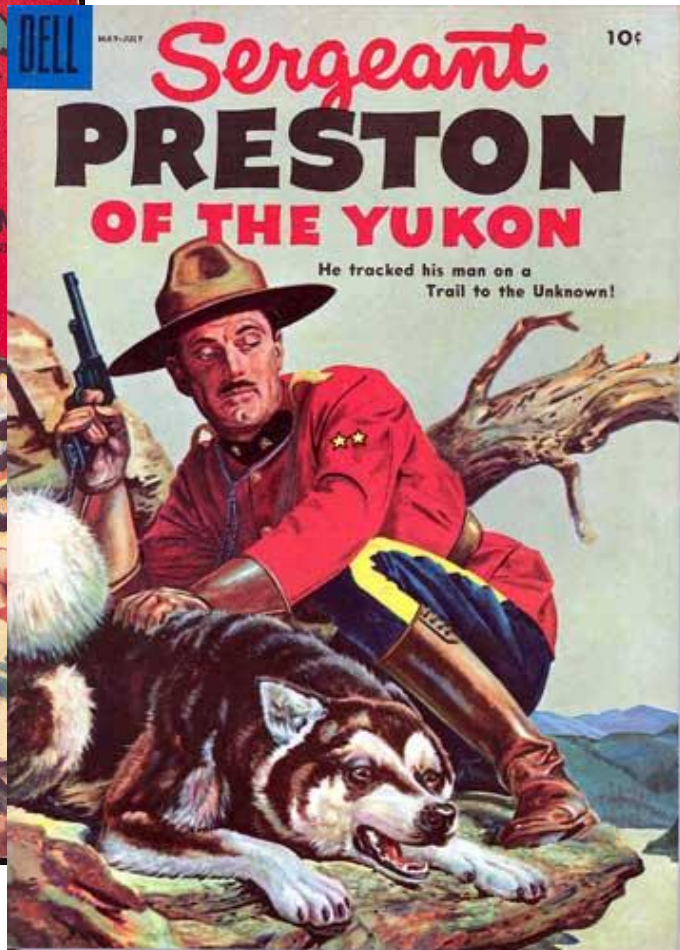
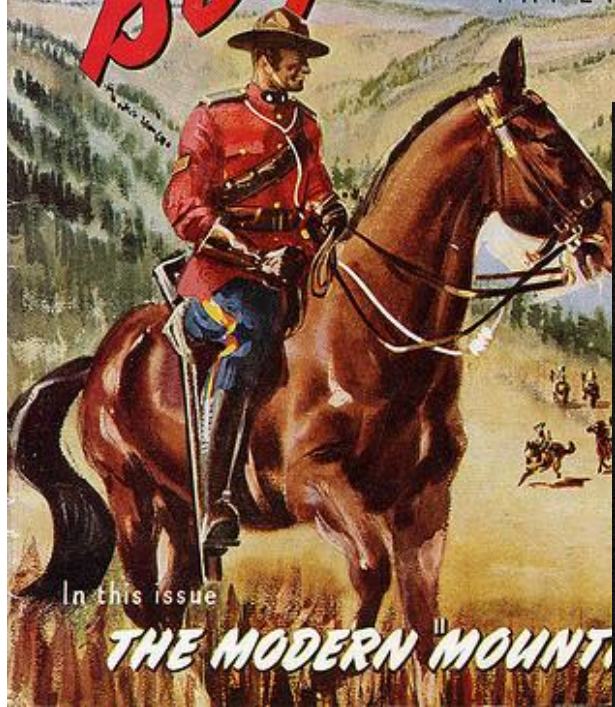

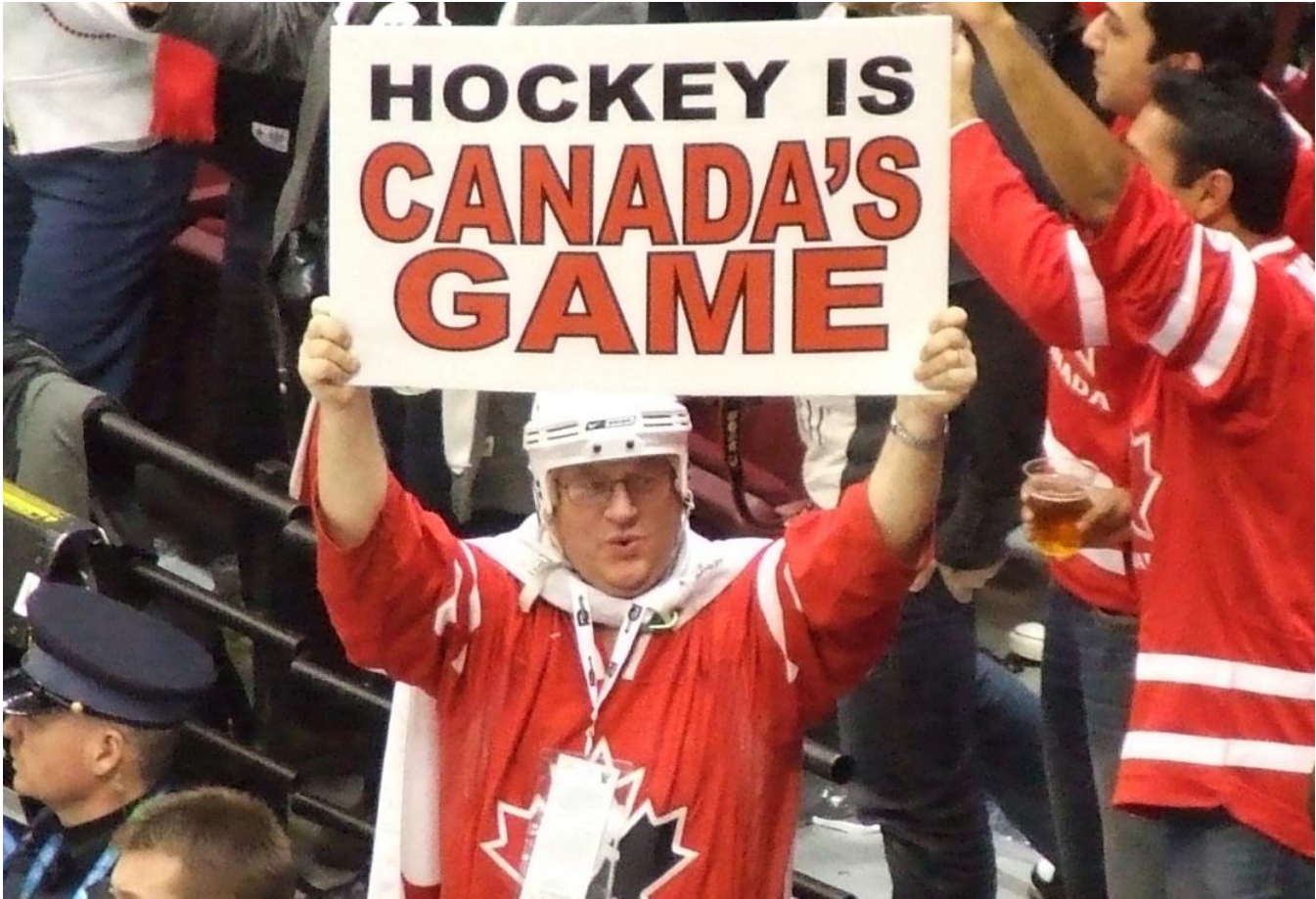
