RAME VOIGE and PASSIVE VOIGE

The <u>active voice</u> of a verb tells us that someone (or something) does the action in a sentence.

James watered the flowers.

Sarah finished the homework.

The puppy chewed the shoe.

The **passive voice** of a verb tells us that someone (or something) has an action done to them.

The flowers were watered by James.

The homework was finished by Sarah.



The shoe was chewed by the puppy.




