England occupies the largest part of the island of Great Britain. Its population is 46 million people.



The climate of England is temperate: temperatures range from -5 degrees C in winter to +25 degrees C in summer.



England is divided into counties.

The highest point of the Highlands is Ben Nevis.



The capital of Wales is Cardiff.



The population of Wales is about 3 million people. Wales is noted for mineral wealth.



The largest towns of Wales are Swansea, Cardiff and Newport.
