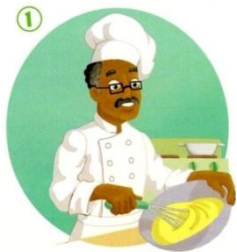

Leonardo is from Rio de Janeiro in Brazil. He lives with **his** parents and brother. His dad is a chef and his mom's an architect. His brother studies English too!

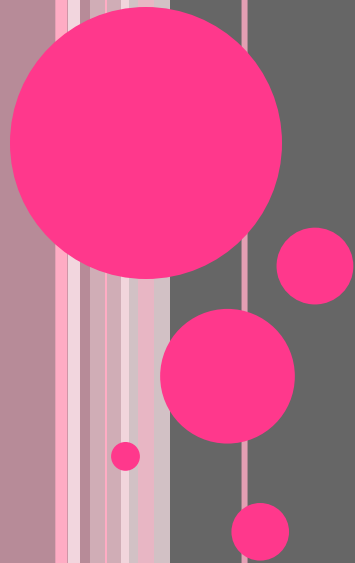
Finally, Samantha is our friend from Switzerland. **Her** English is excellent! Her mom is a doctor, and I think her dad's a mechanic.
