50%	<b>Sometimes</b>	I <i>sometimes</i> forget my wife's birthday.
30%	<b>Occasionally</b>	I <i>occasionally</i> eat junk food.
10%	<b>Seldom/rarely/almost</b>	I <i>seldom</i> read the newspaper.
5%	<b>Hardly ever</b>	I <i>hardly ever</i> drink alcohol.
0%	<b>Never</b>	I <i>never</i> swim in the sea.

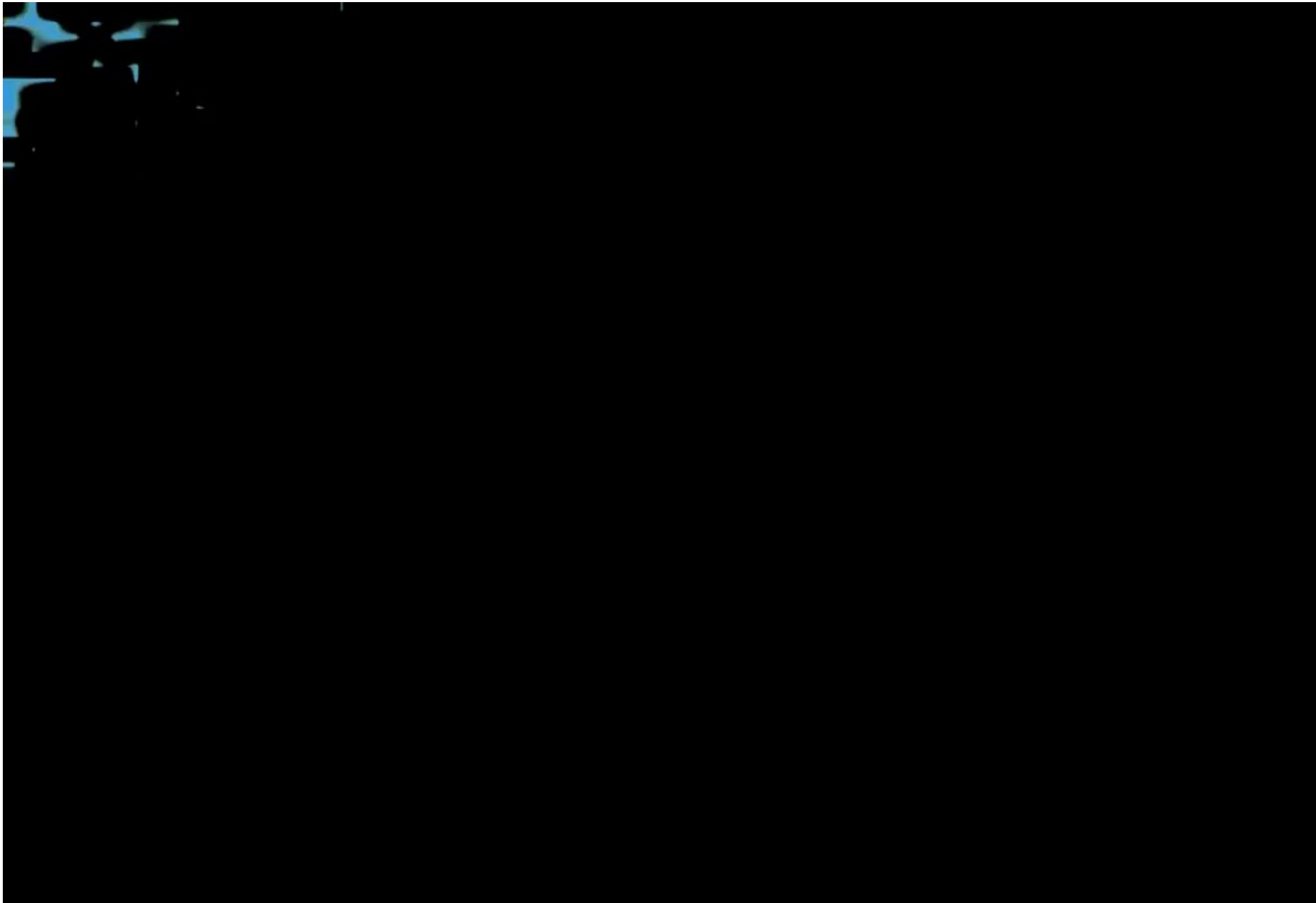
