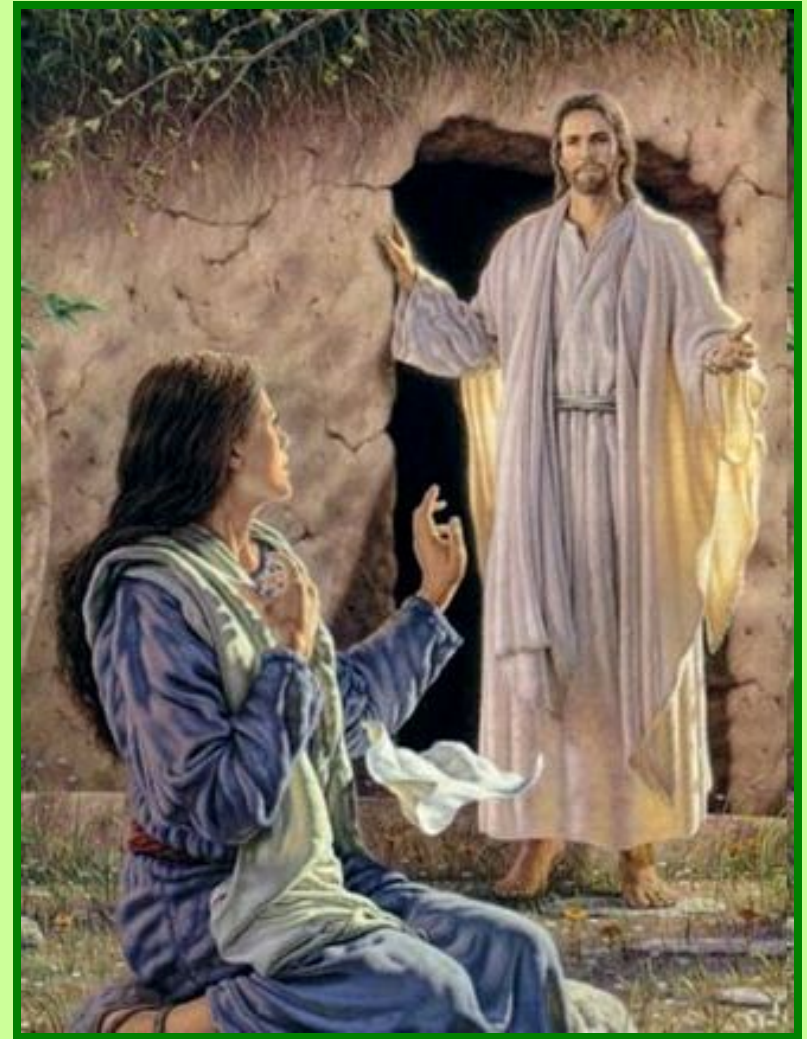




Easter in Great Britain

The history of the holiday

Easter is a festival of overwhelming joy. The joy that celebrates the victory of life over death. *Easter* celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus Christ on the third day after his Crucifixion.



Easter Symbols

Eggs and chicks symbolize new life. Eggs have been a symbol of spring since ancient times.



The chick, hatching out of the egg, symbolizes new life or re-birth.

The exchange of eggs in the springtime is a custom
From the earliest times, the egg was a symbol of birth in most cultures.

Today, children hunt colored eggs and place them in Easter baskets along with the modern version of real Easter eggs -- those made of plastic or chocolate candy.

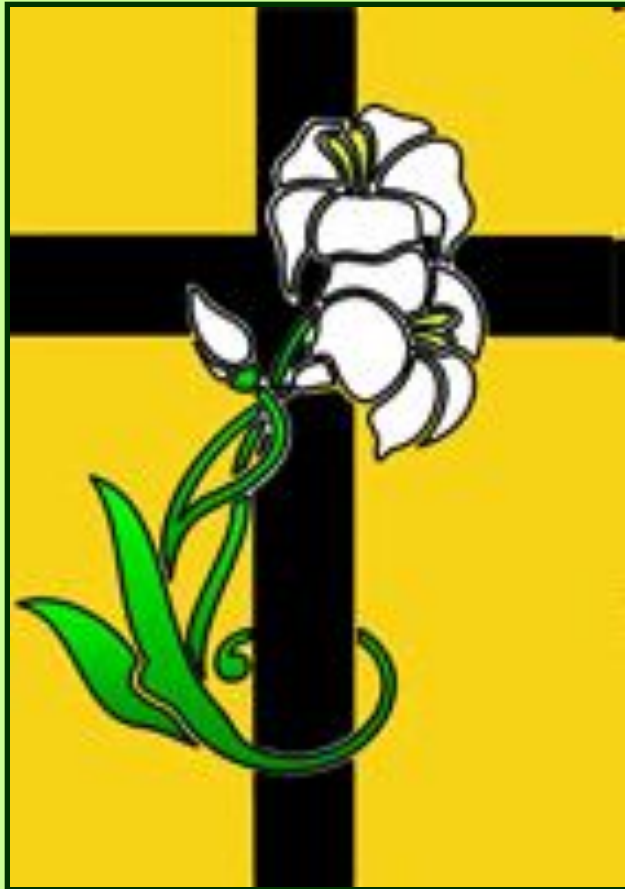


Easter bunny - The rabbit, or hare, was a symbol of new life in ancient times, and reminds us of spring and new life.



Easter Lilies - The white blossoms symbolize the purity of Jesus. Lilies in the spring also symbolize new life.

the beginning of spring



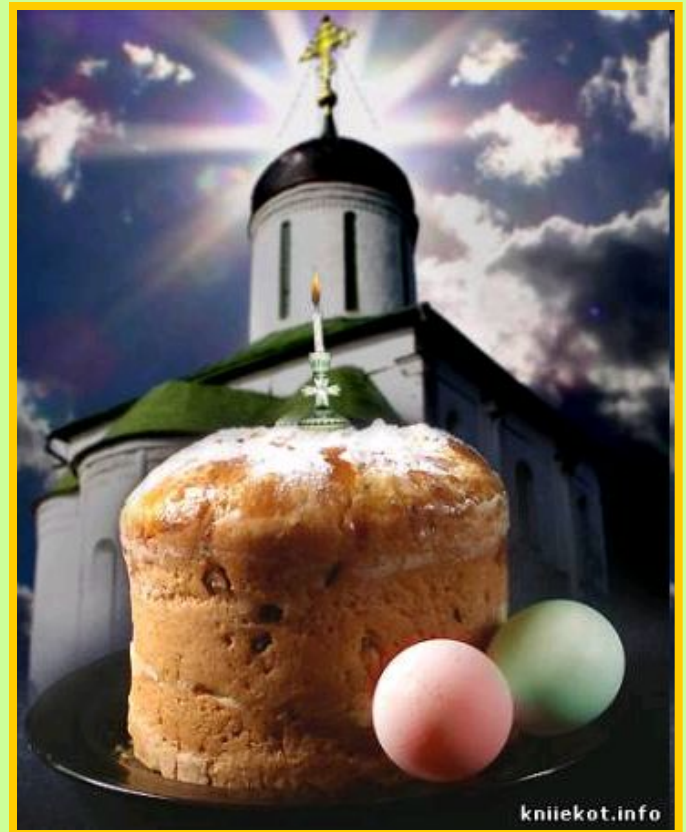
The cross - Symbolizes Jesus'

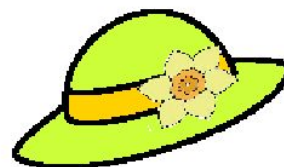
