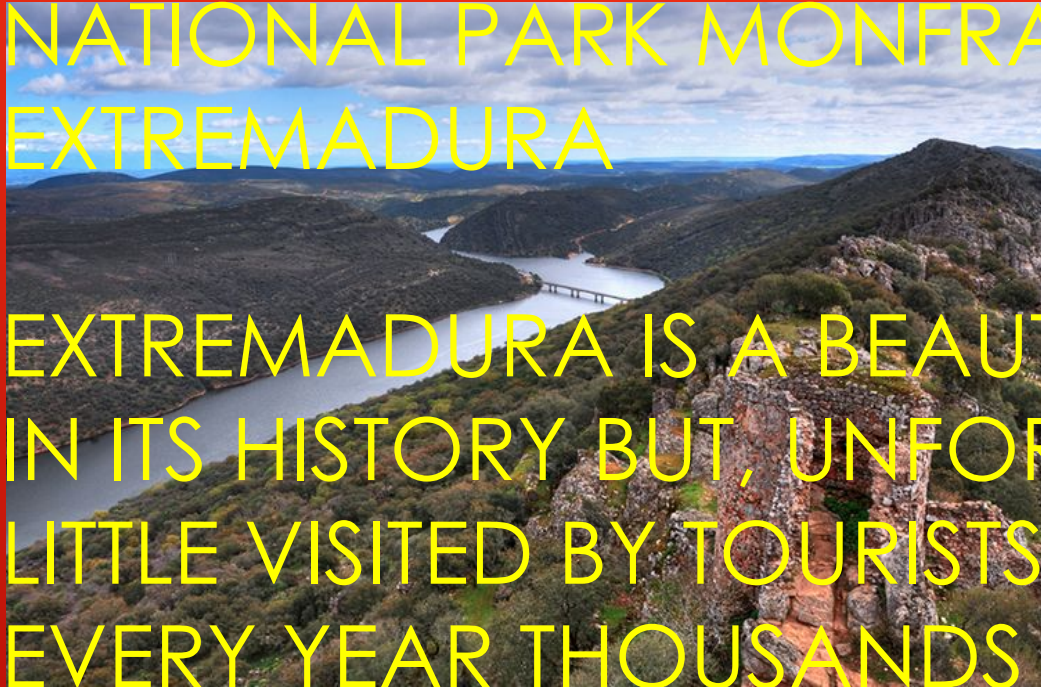

THE NATIONAL PARK ARCHIPELAGO OF CABRERA, BALEARIC ISLANDS

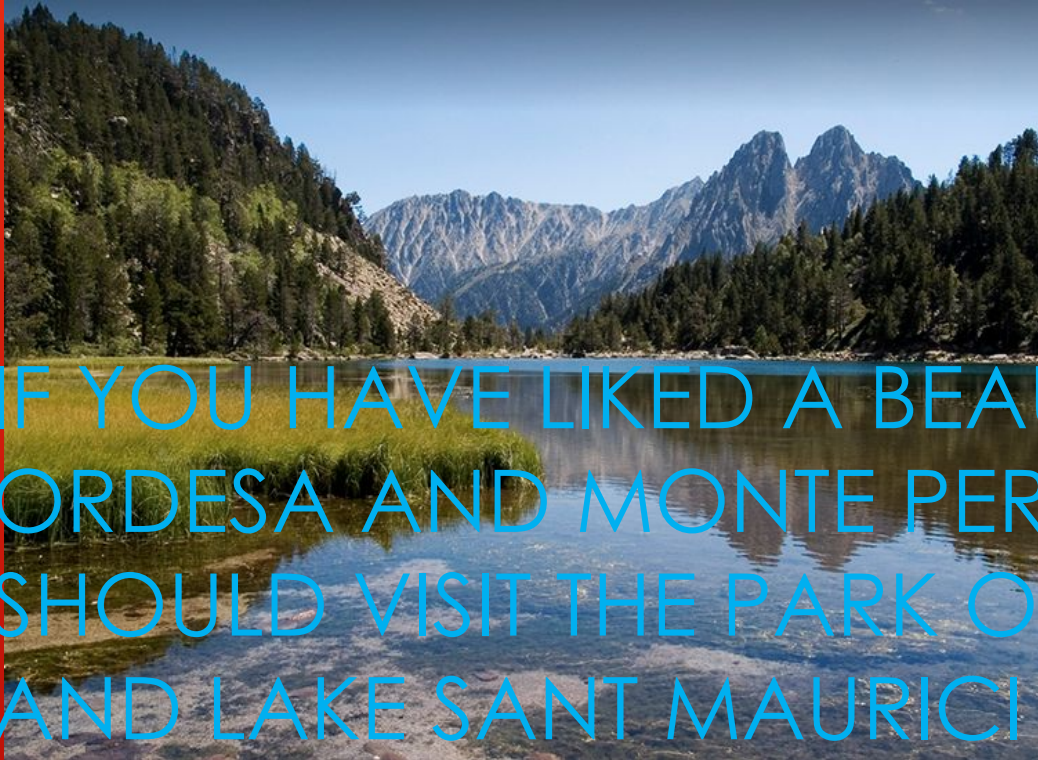

Catalonia

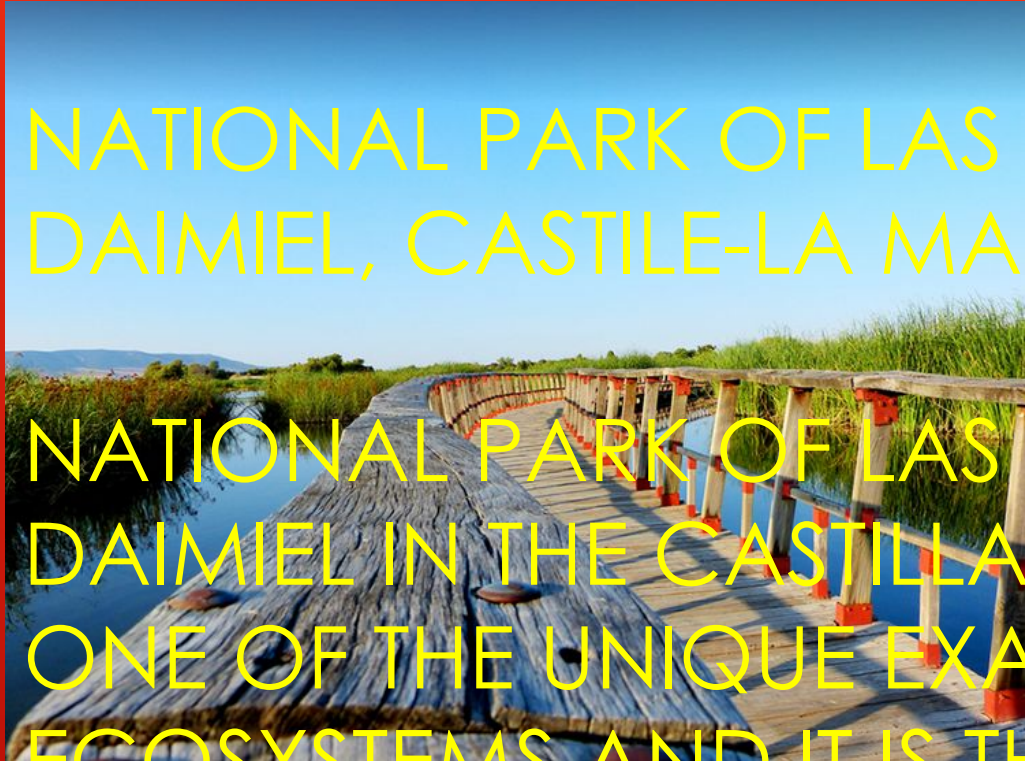

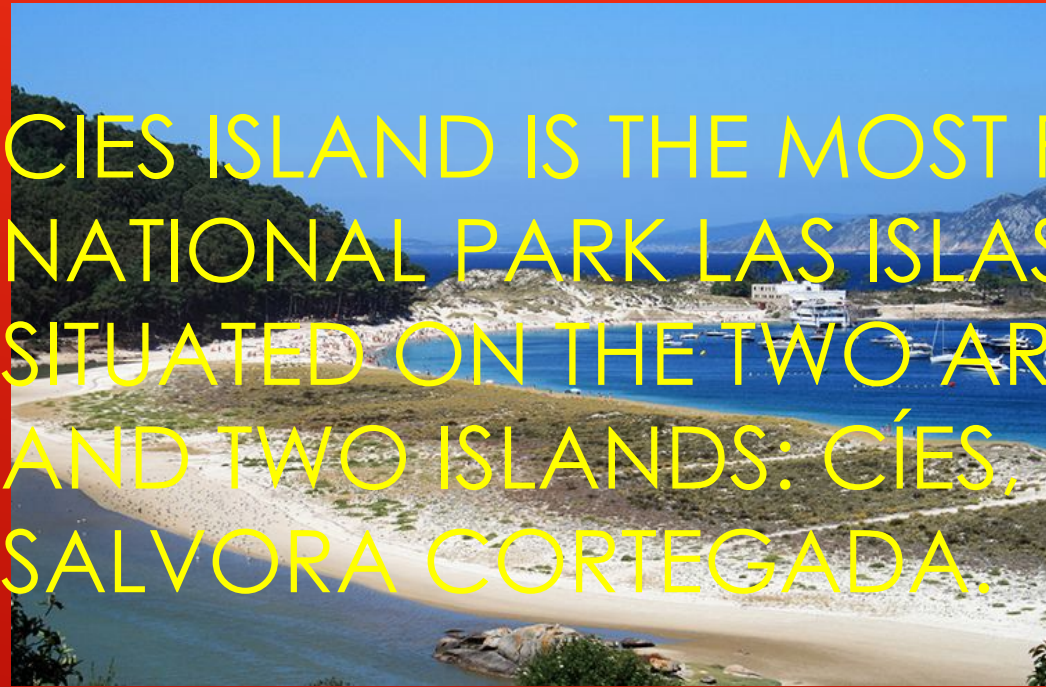


NATIONAL PARK OF LAS TABLAS DE

NUTRIA, OTTERS, DUCKS AND MANY
WATER BIRDS AND SMALL ANIMALS

CIES ISLAND IS THE MOST FAMOUS, NATIONAL PARK LAS ISLAS ATLANTIKAS IS SITUATED ON THE TWO ARCHIPELAGOS AND TWO ISLANDS: CÍES, ONS, AND SALVORA CORTEGADA.

THE ISLANDS ARE LOCATED IN THE VICINITY OF THE ENTRANCE TO THE BAY OF VIGO, IT IS A NATURAL BREAKWATER. WE CAN VISIT THE ISLAND ON THE SHIP, WHICH DEPARTS REGULARLY FROM THE MARINA IN VIGO.





▶ Doñana National Park, Andalusia

DOÑANA NATIONAL PARK IS A WETLAND WITH ESTUARIES AND DUNES, LOCATED ON THE BORDER OF THE PROVINCES OF HUELVA AND SEVILLE.

DOÑANA NATIONAL PARK IS A HOME AND A REFUGE FOR ENDANGERED SPECIES SUCH AS THE SWAN, COOT, THE IBERIAN LYNX, TO SEE THAT MANY TOURISTS COME HERE.
