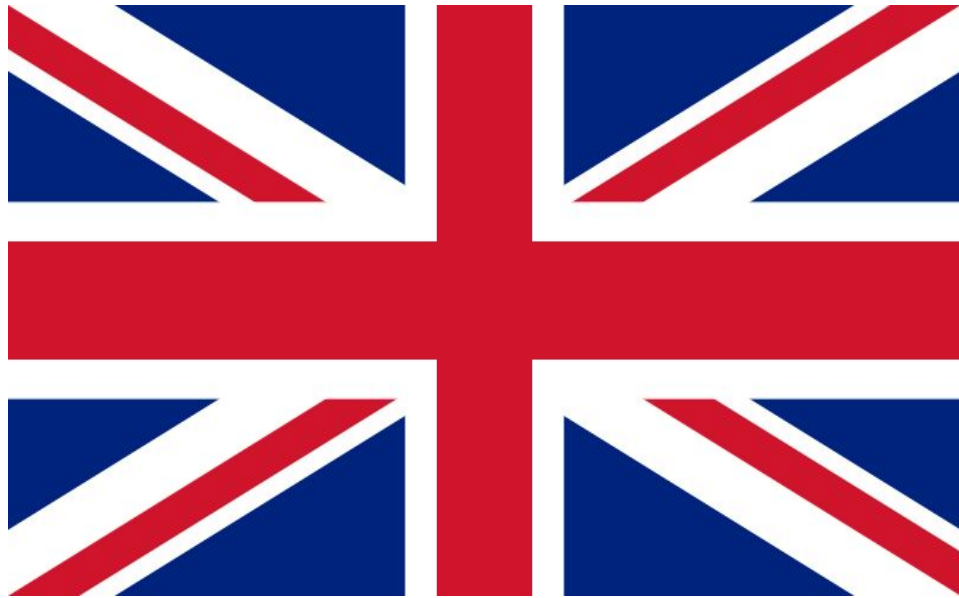

THE GREAT BELL AND THE QUARTER BELL IN THEIR PLACES IN THE CLERE TOWER, WESTMINSTER.

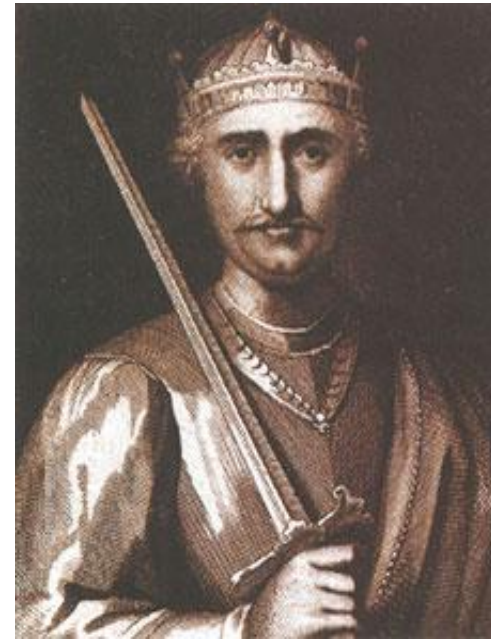

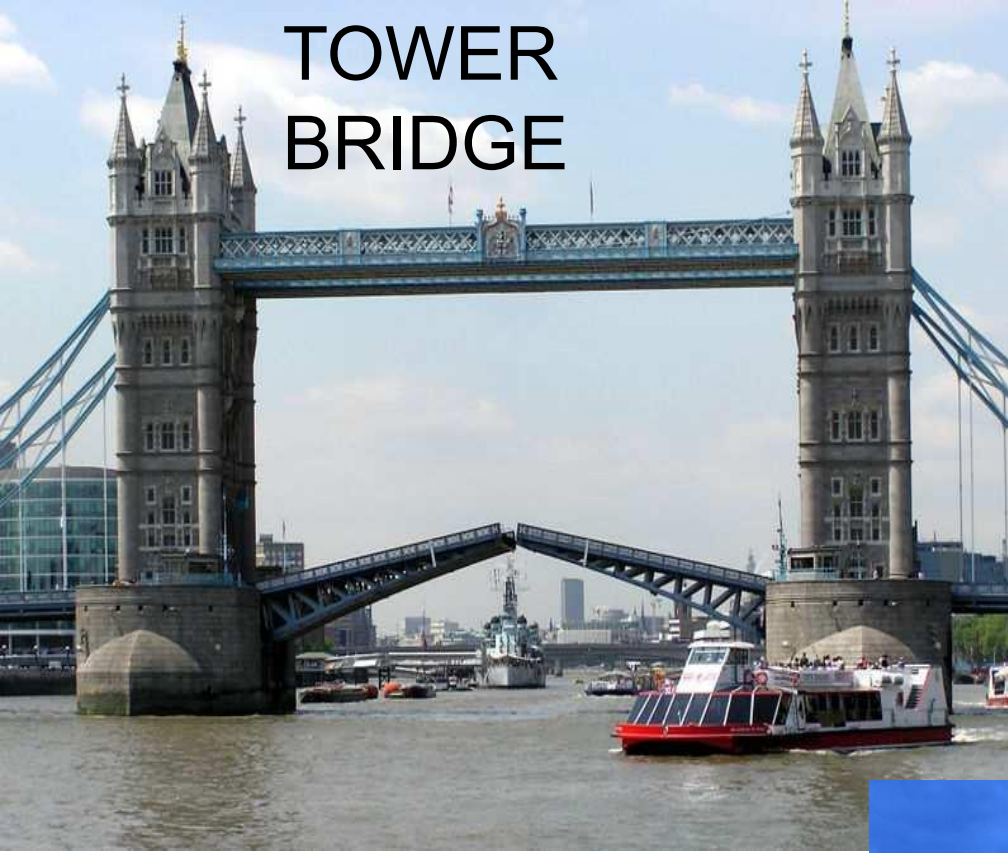
