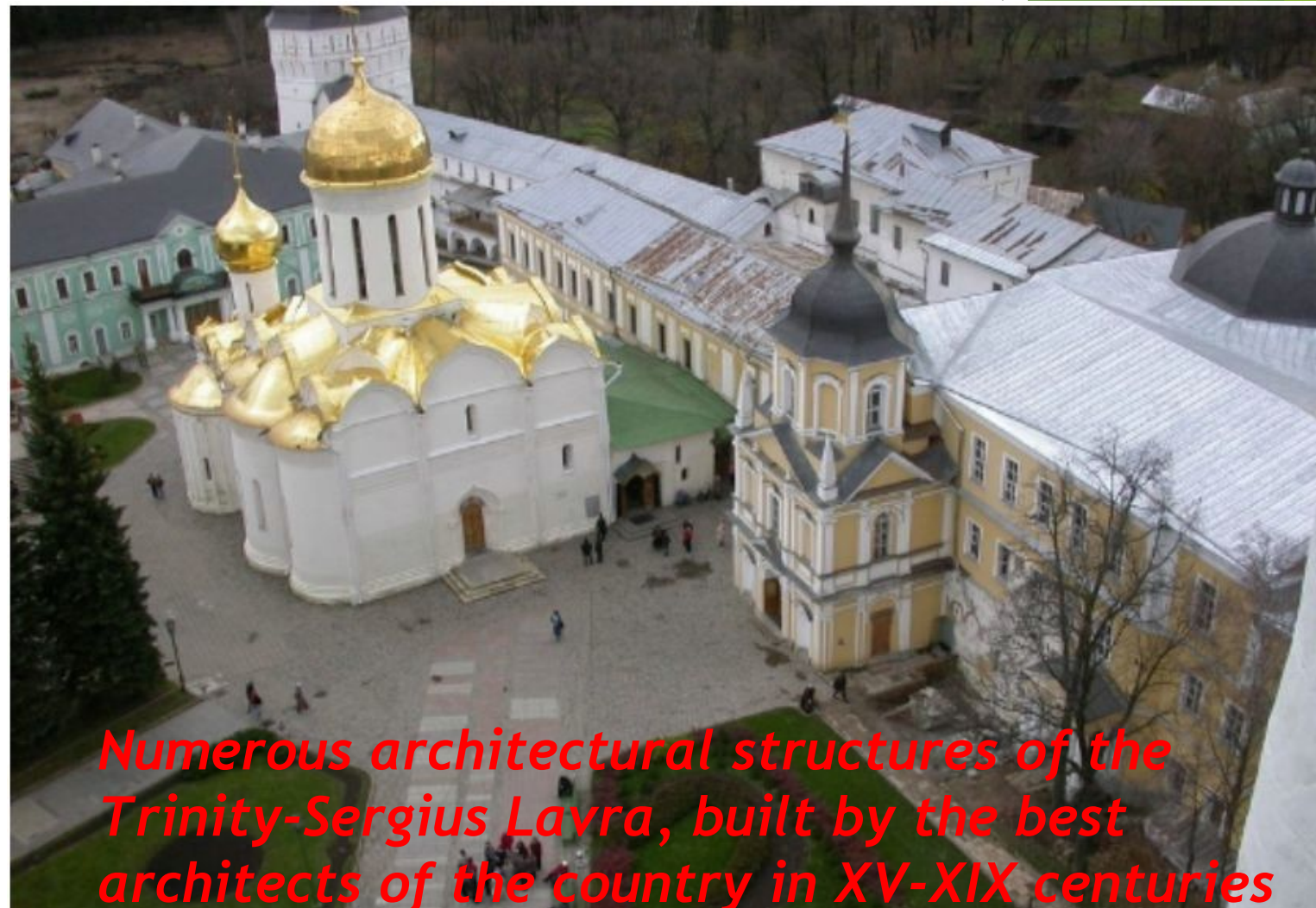
The Golden Ring

This single-domed cross four pillars apses temple is the earliest of white stone architectural monuments of North-Eastern Russia

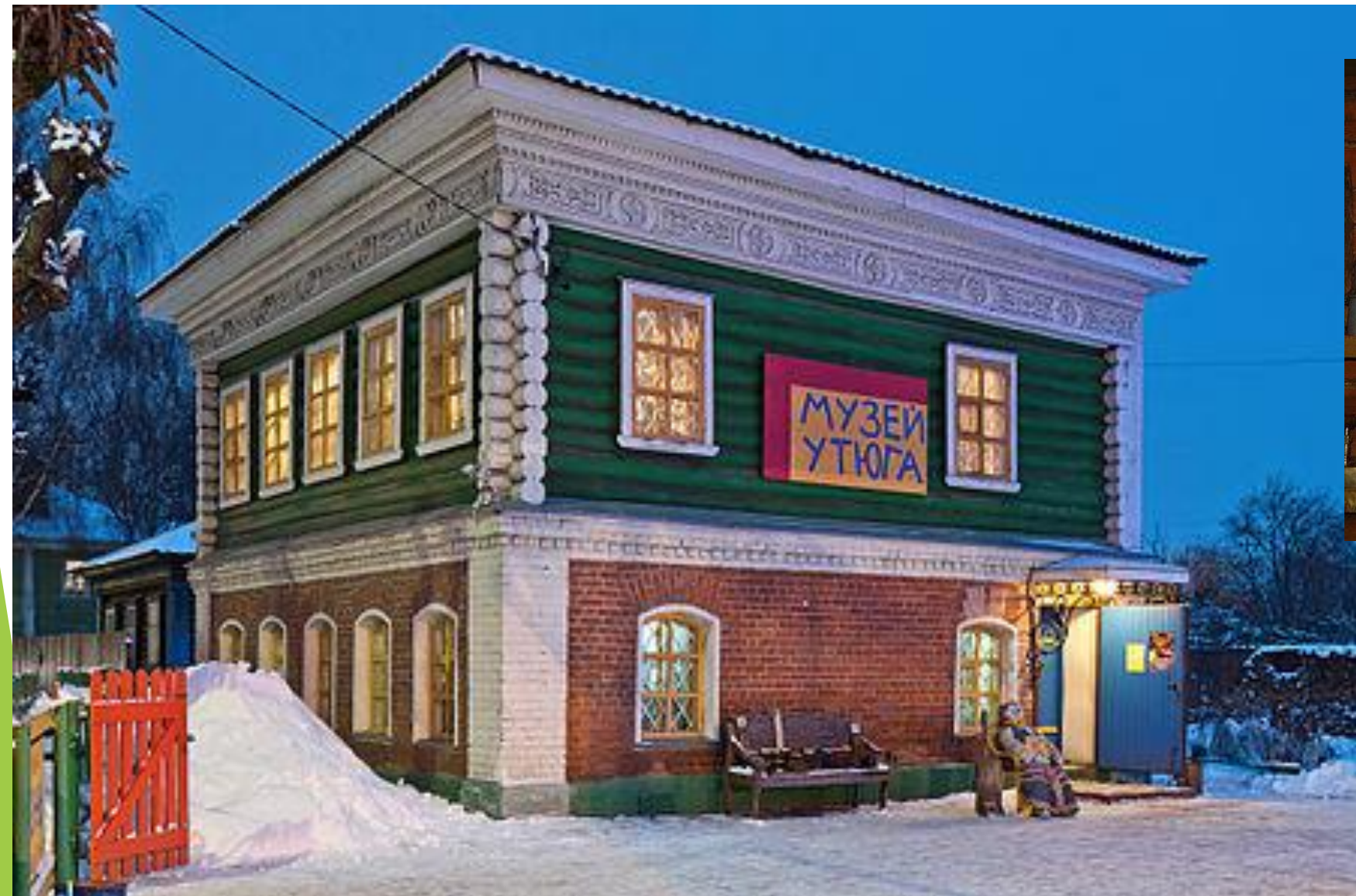

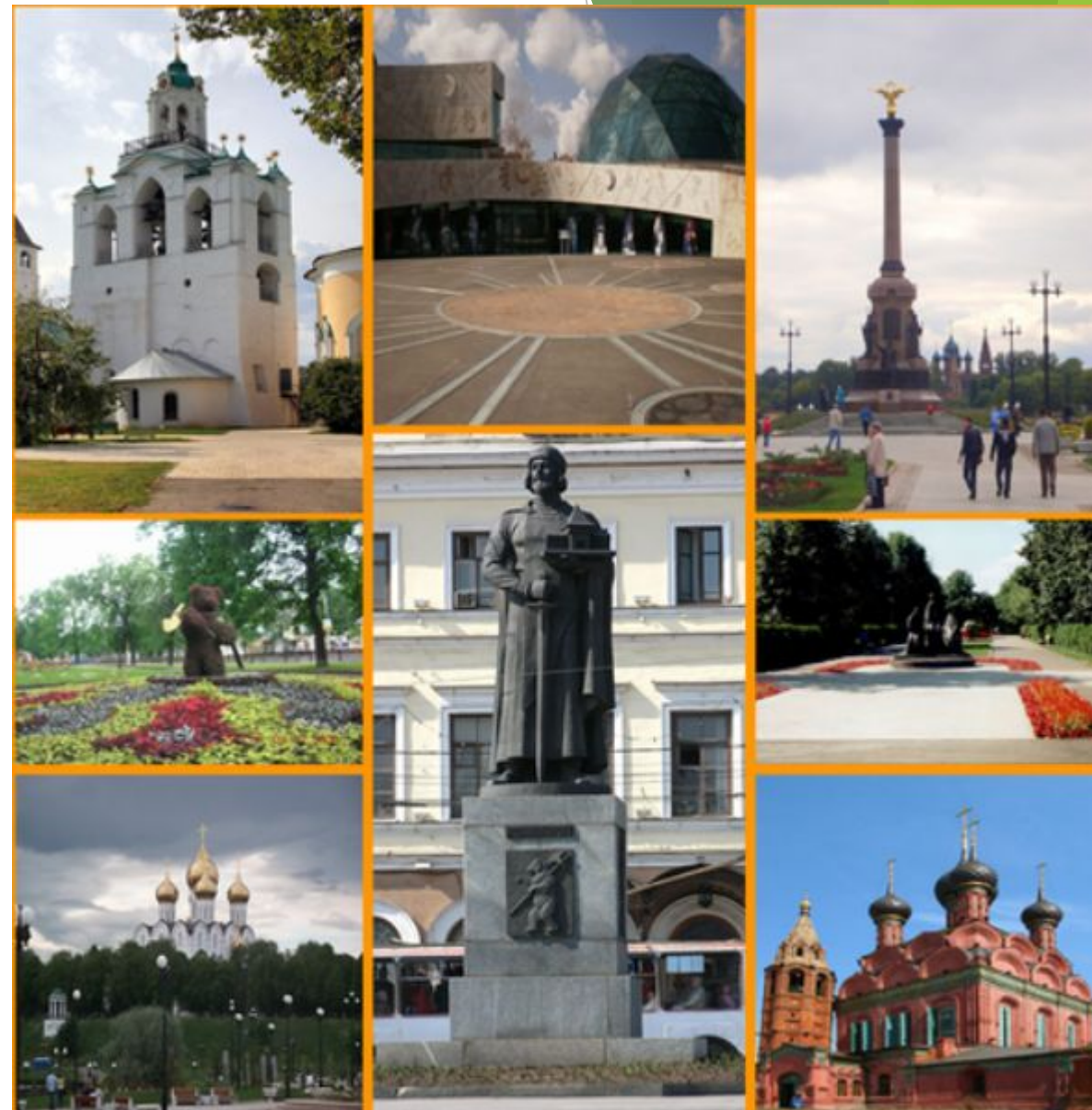

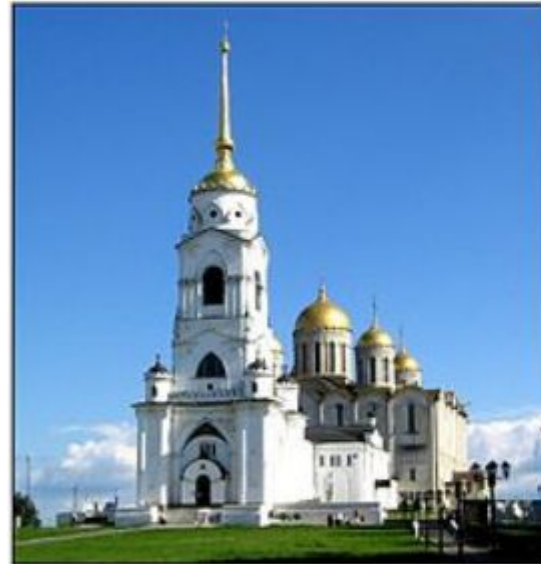
