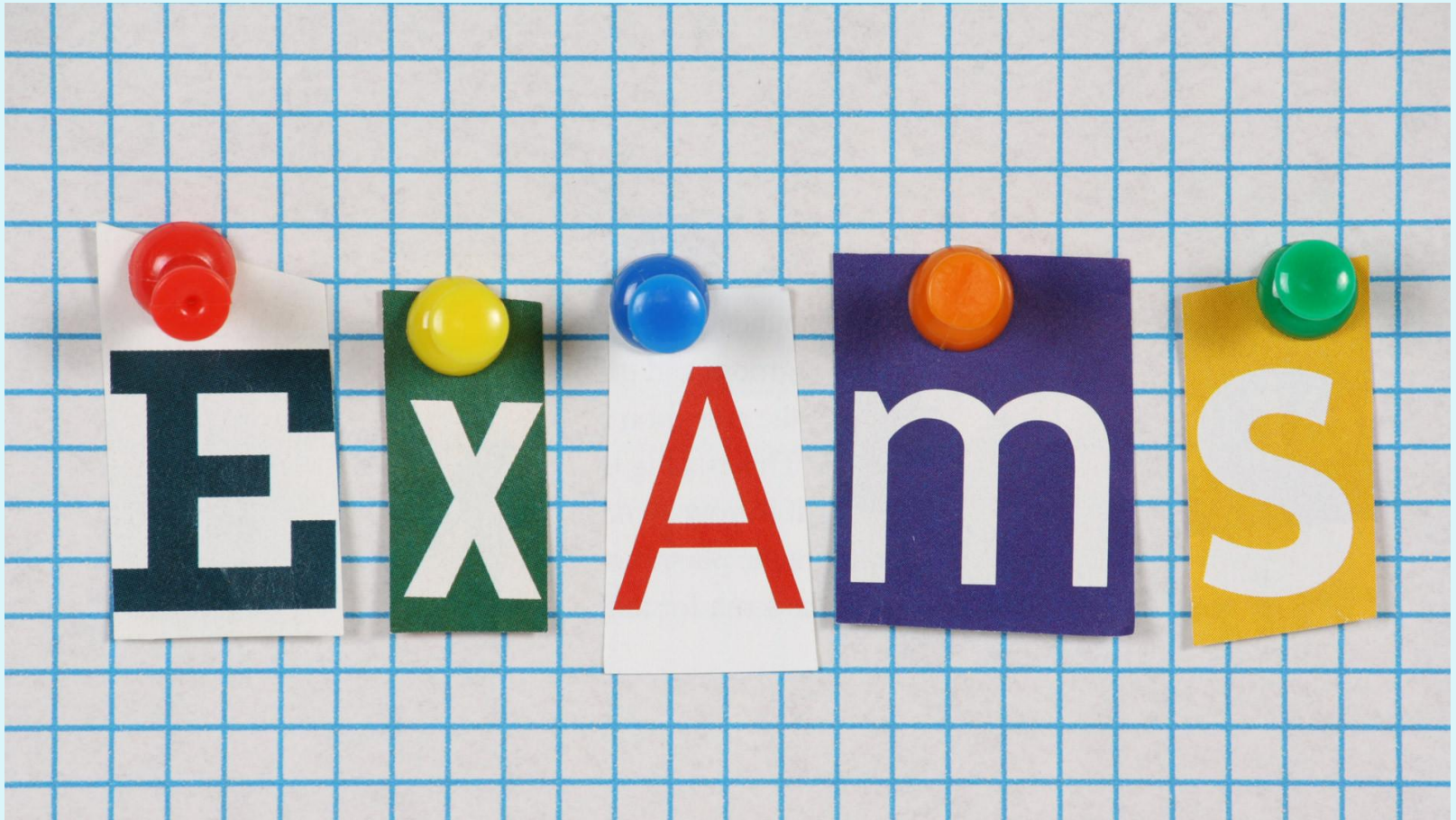

I - Я

You - ТЫ

He - ОН

She - ОНА

It - ОН, ОНА, ОНО

We - МЫ

You - ВЫ

They - ОНИ

Possessive Pronouns

(Притяжательные
местоимения)

Whose? (Чей?)

my - мой

your - твой

his - его

her - ее

its - его, её

our – наш

your - ваш

their – их

This is his book.

These are their toys

his book

their toys

Абсолютная форма притяжательных местоимений

mine [maɪn] — мой

yours [jɔːz] — твой

his [hɪz] — его

hers [hɛː (r)z] — ее

its [ɪts] — его

ours [aʊəz] — наш

yours [jɔːz] — ваш

theirs [ðeəz] — их

This is **his book** but that is **mine**.

Object Pronouns

(Кого? Кому? Кем? О ком?)

Me –меня, мне, мной, обо мне

You – тебя, тебе, тобой, о тебе

Him – его, ему, им, о нём

Her – её, ей, ею, о ней

It – его, ему, им, о нём

Us – нас, нам, нами, о нас

You – вас, вам, вами, о вас

Them – их, им, ими, о них

I don't **believe him**. – Я **ему** не верю.

Reflexive Pronouns

(Возвратные местоимения)
- self, - selves

myself [mai'self]

yourself [jɔ:'self]

himself [him'self]

herself [hɛ:(r)'self]

itself [it'self]

ourselves [a:'selvz]

yourselves [jɔ:selvz]

themselves [ðəm'selvz]

I cut **myself** while shaving. (Я порезал**ся** во время бритья.)

She can do the homework **herself**.

(Она может выполнить домашнее задание самостоятельно (**сама**)).

Demonstrative Pronouns

(Указательные местоимения)

This - эта, этот, это
эти



These -

That - та, тот, то

Those - те
