There is a book **on the table**.

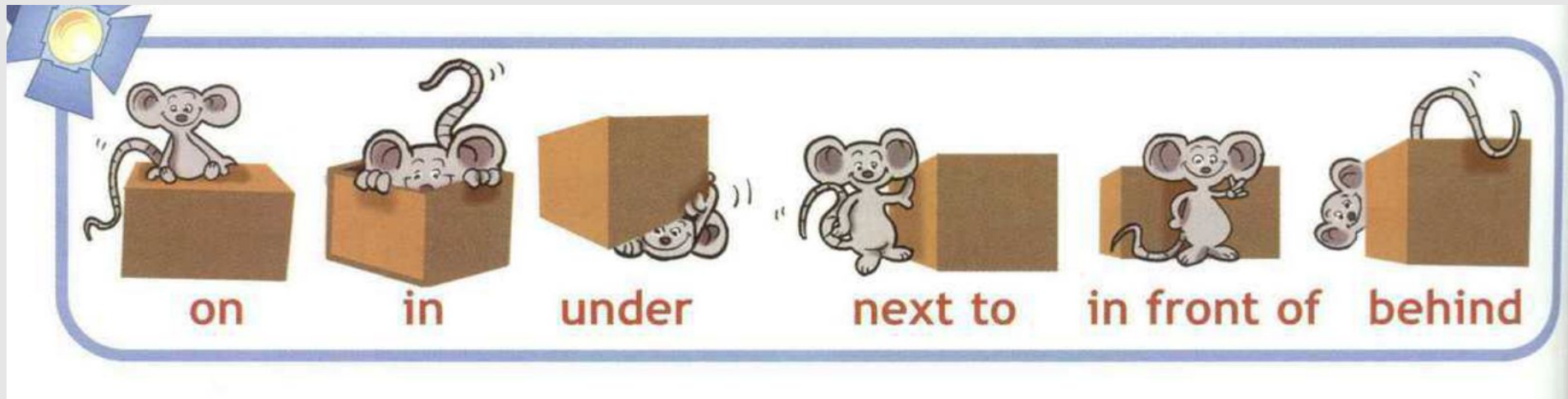
**На столе** есть книга.

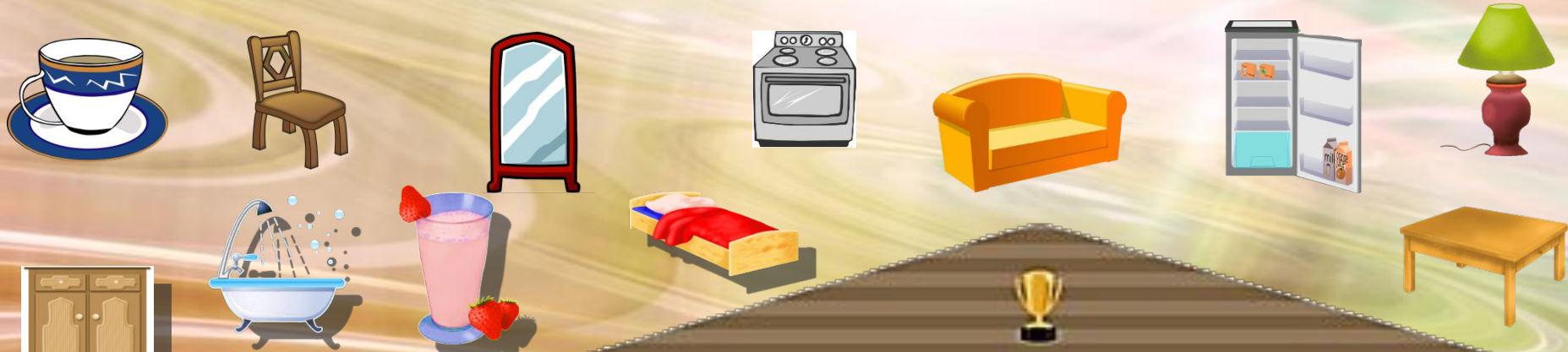
