Are we going to visit Great Britain?



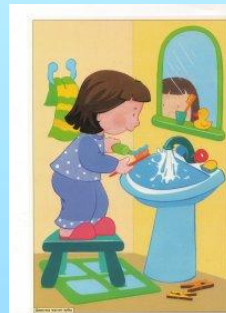

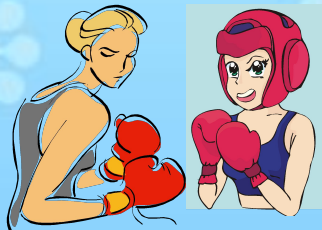

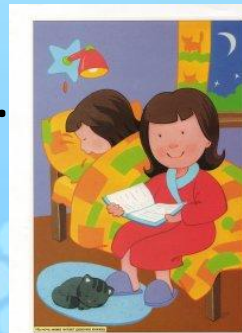
