There are **three** semesters. They have no school on the following: **Thanksgiving, Christmas, Easter** and during **summer** vacation.

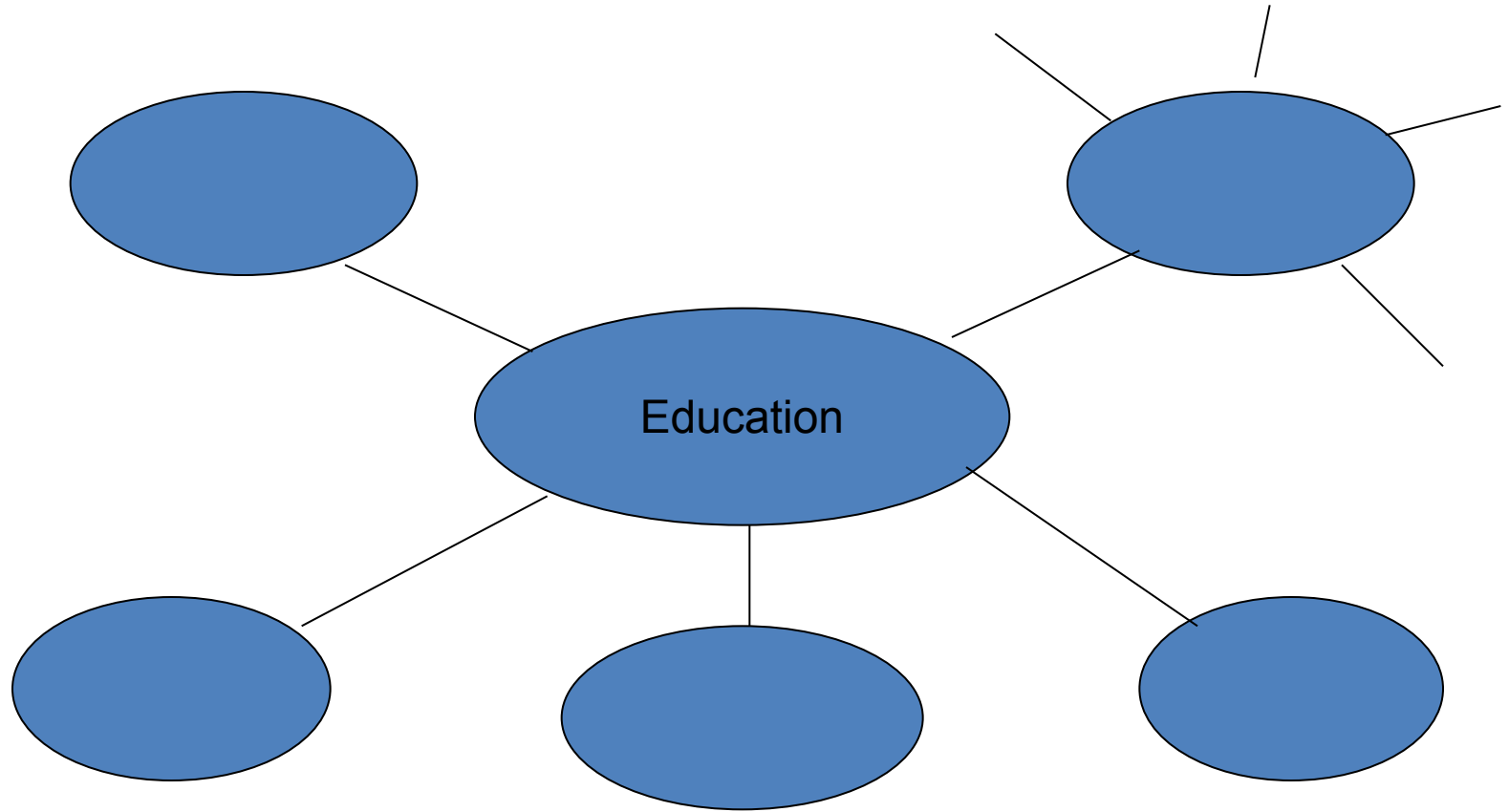
The compulsory subjects are **English, Maths, Science, Social Studies and Physical Education**.
