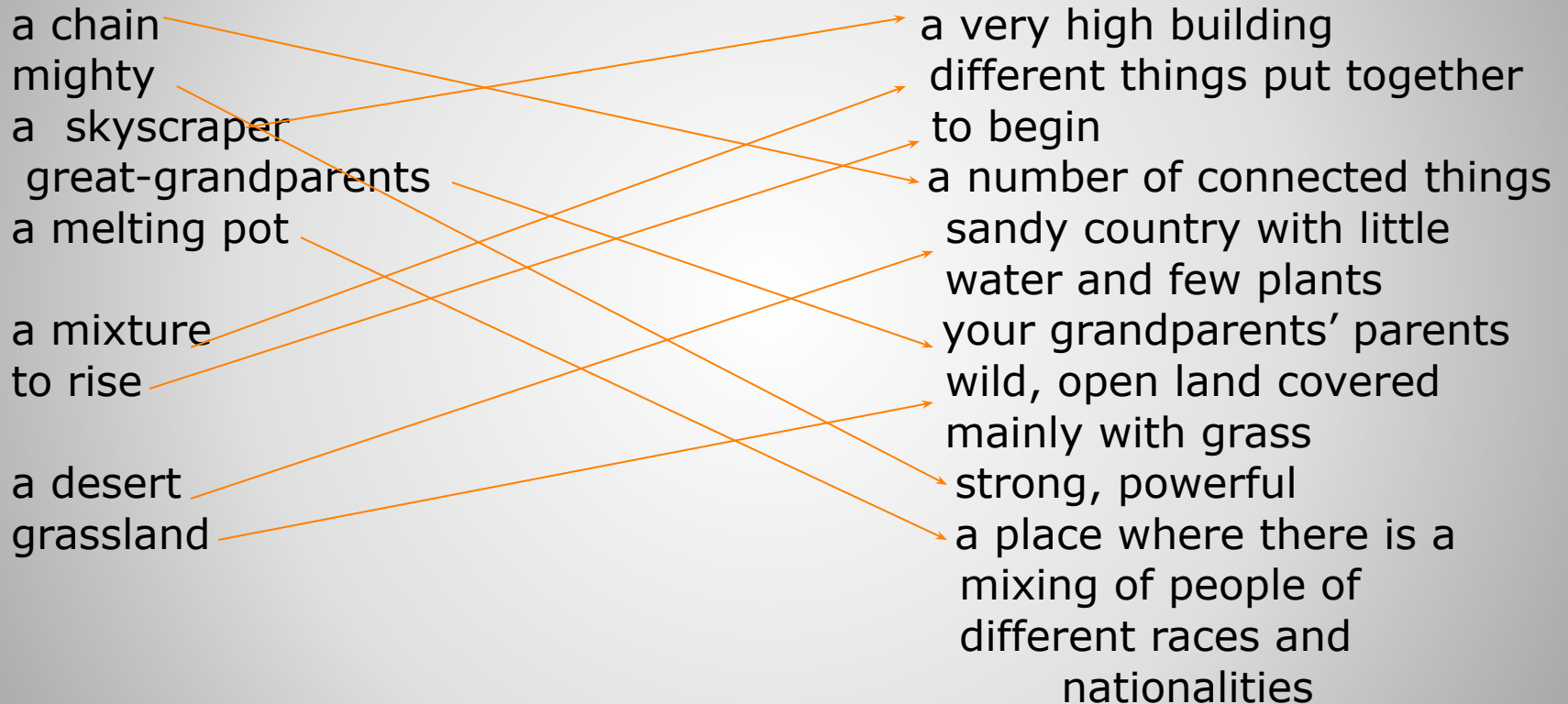
- There are fifty states in the United States of America.

- high mountains, great forests, sunny beaches, lands of endless winter.

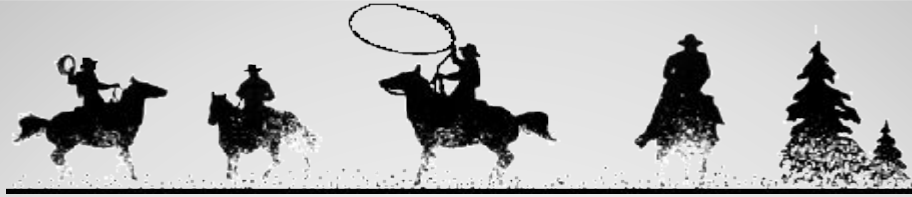
