Придаточное предложение выражает условие совершение действия, главное-следствие, вытекающее из этого условия.

Придаточные предложения условия обычно соединяются С главным предложением союзом if

If you see Ann, tell her to ring me up.

If he works hard, he can easily catch up with the other students in his English.

We will go for a walk if we have time.

Условные предложения I типа выражают реальные, осуществимые условия, обычно относящиеся к будущему (или настоящему) времени.

If the weather is fine, he will go to the country.

В условных предложениях I типа, относящихся к будущему, в придаточном предложении после союза if глагол ставится в Present Simple, а в главном предложении употребляется Future Simple или повелительное наклонение.

If we go to the cinema earlier, we will be able to get good seats.

If he comes, ask him to wait for me.

Условные предложения II типа выражают маловерные и нереальные условия, относящиеся к настоящему или будущему времени.

If I had time now, I would go to the concert, but I'm busy.

В условных предложениях II типа в придаточном предложении употребляется Past Simple, а в главном предложении — сочетание would c Indefinite (без to)

If he knew where we lived, he would send us a telegram.

Для справок.

Глагол to be в придаточном предложении употребляется в форме were со всеми лицами единственного и множественого числа.

If I were you, I would go to the doctor at once.

Условные предложения III типа выражают условия, не реализованные в прошлом, а поэтому совершенно невыполнимые.

If I had had time yesterday, I would have gone to the concert, but I'm busy.

В условных предложениях III типа в придаточном предложении употребляется Past Perfect, а в главном предложении – сочетание would с Perfect (без to)

If he had seen you yesterday, he would have told you about the meeting.


If he hadn't rained last Sunday, we would have gone to the country.


Типы	Условия	Время событий	Примеры
I	Real	Future	If I have time, I will go for a walk.
II	Unreal	Present, Future	If I had time now, I would go for a walk. If I saw my friend tomorrow, I would ask him about it.
III	Unreal	Past	If I had had time yesterday, I would have gone for a walk.
