## High Tea VERSUS Afternoon Tea



High Tea was traditionally served at high tables, for the lower class.

Informal occasion - for those who were hungry after a long, laborious day of work.

Served evening around the hours of 6:00pm or 7:00pm

A substantial meal consisting of dishes like meat, fish, bread, etc.



Afternoon Tea was traditionally served at low tables, for the upper class.

Formal occasion - social gathering with fine china, dainty finger foods, fascinator, etc.

Served mid-afternoon around the hours of 3:00pm or 4:00pm

A light meal consisting of savouries, tea sandwiches, scones and sweets.

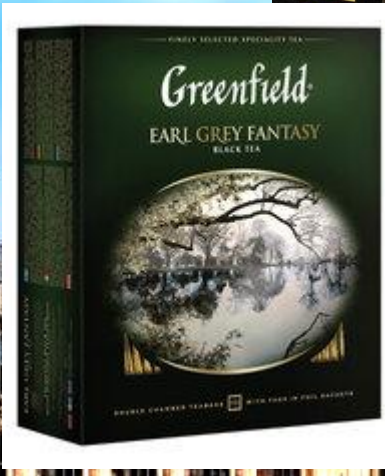
