The largest cities: Sydney, Melbourn, Brisbane, Perth, Adelaide


Australia's area of 7,617,930 square kilometres

Australia has 34,218 kilometres of coastline (excluding all offshore islands).

The most part of territory of the country is occupied with deserts and lowlands. Known deserts: the Big Sandy desert, the Big Victoria desert.

The climate of Australia is significantly influenced by ocean currents. Much of the northern part of the country has a tropical summer rainfall (monsoon).
