







Russia's parliament, which is called the Federal Assembly,

Members of the State Duma are elected by the people to four-year terms. Members of the Federation Council are local government officials. These members include regional governors and leaders of local legislatures. They are not elected directly to the council but gain membership when they attain the local office.

All Russian citizens 18 years of age and older may vote in the country's elections.

The head of the state is the President.
