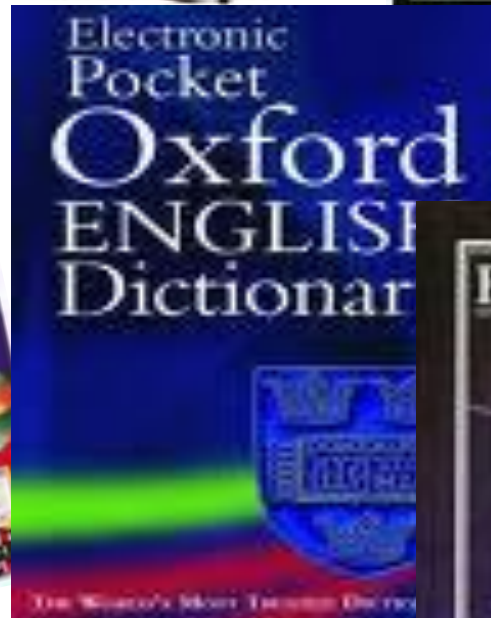
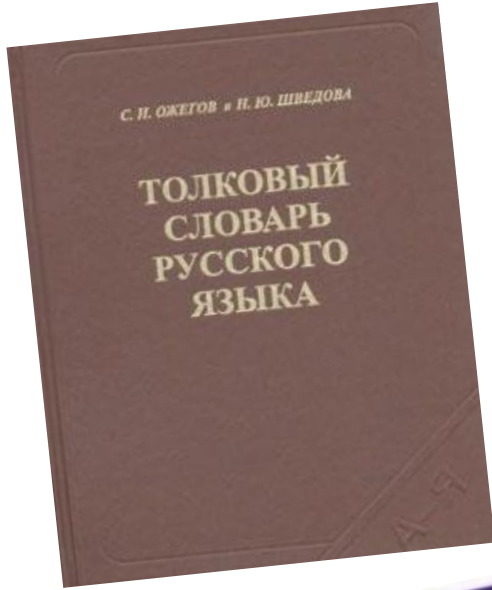

The world famous dictionaries



Vladimir Dahl



The Dahl

- Dal served in the Russian Navy from 1814 to 1826, graduating from the St. Petersburg Naval Cadet School in 1819. In 1826, he began studying medicine at Dorpat University and took part as a military doctor in the Russo-Turkish War (1828–1829) and the campaign against Poland in 1831-1832. Following disagreement with his superiors, he resigned from the Military Hospital in St. Petersburg and took an administrative position with the Ministry of the Interior in Orenburg Governorate, serving in similar positions in St. Petersburg and Nizhny Novgorod before his retirement in 1859.
- Dal was interested in language and folklore from his early years. He started travelling by foot through the Russian countryside, collecting sayings and fairy tales of the Russian people. He published his first collection of fairy-tales in 1832. Some others, yet unpublished, were put in verse by his friend Alexander Pushkin, and have become some of the most familiar texts in the language. After Pushkin's fatal duel, Dal was summoned to his deathbed and looked after the great poet during the last hours of his life.

Dahl dictionary

- The encompassing nature of Dals dictionary gives it critical linguistic importance even today ,especially because a large proportion of the dialectal vocabulary he collected has since passed out of use.



Vladimir Dal is buried in the Vagankovskoye cemetery in Moscow.

Sergey Ivanovich Ozhegov



- *Sergey Ivanovich Ozhegov was born on September, 23rd (on October, 10th) 1900 in a settlement Stone district Novotorzhskogo of the Tver province. In the spring 1909 has moved with Family to Petersburg and has started to study in 5-th grammar school. In the summer 1918 has ended a grammar school and has acted on faculty of linguistics of material culture of Petrograd university. But in the end 1918 has left university and was enlisted Self-defined in Red Army. After the termination of military actions has returned on philological faculty of Petrograd university.*

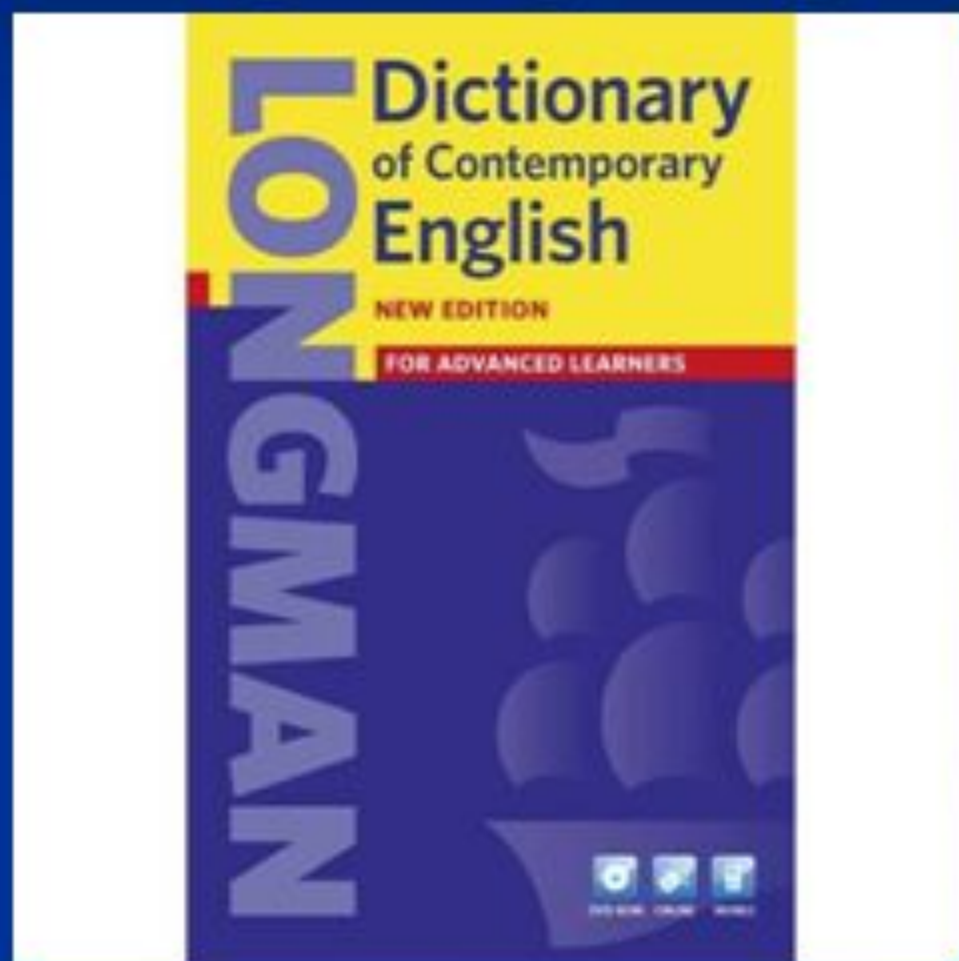
- In 1926 has finished training and on recommendation of the teachers V.V. Vinogradova, L.V. Shcherby and B.M. Lyapunov has been recommended in postgraduate study of Institute of history of literatures and languages of the West and the East at the Leningrad state university.
- With the end of 1920th has begun work above « the Explanatory dictionary of Russian » which editor was G.N. Ushakov. On the basis of S.I. Ozhegov's specified lexicographic product has created one-volume « the Dictionary of Russian ».
- In 1950th has organized the Center on studying a standard of speech at Institute of Russian of the Academy of sciences of the USSR. During same time under its edition and in the co-authorship the well-known dictionaries to say norms were published. Was the founder of new scientific magazine « Russian speech » (first number has left after S.I. Ozhegov's death in 1967).
- Sociolinguistic S.I. Ozhegov's researches have formed a basis for promotion of a scientific problem by it « Russian and the Soviet society ». The monography in 4 books « Russian and the Soviet society. Sociolinguistic research » it has been published in 1968, already after death of the scientist.

Explanatory dictionary of Russian



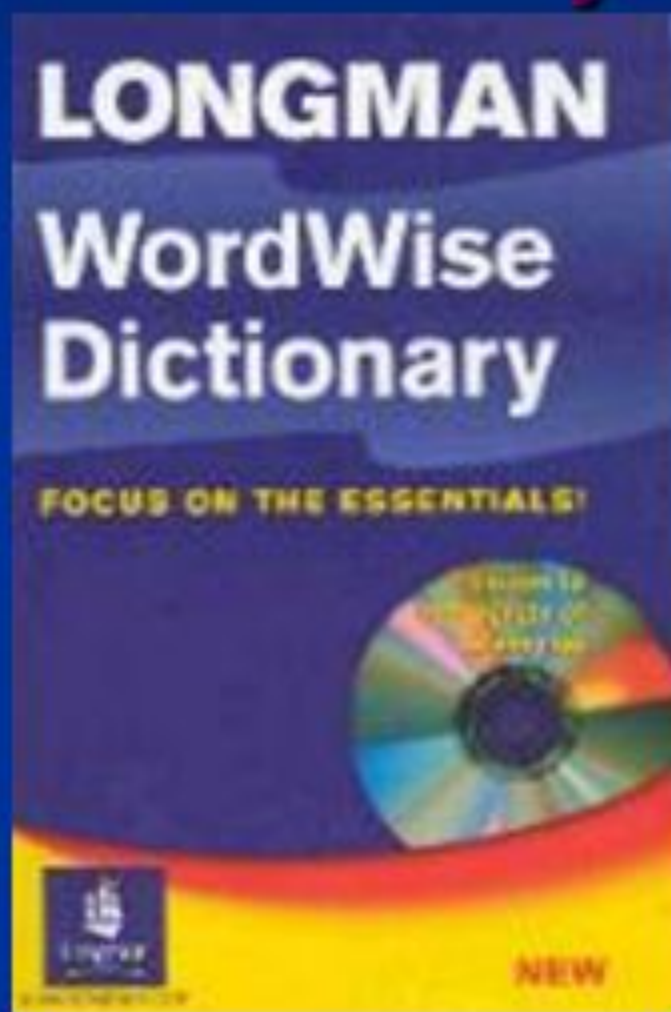
- *The explanatory dictionary of Russian contains 80 000 words and phraseological expressions (including the heading words, derivative words) both idioms. Words and the phraseological units included in an explanatory dictionary, concern to common-literary Russian lexicon, and also to special spheres of language cooperating with it; in an explanatory dictionary are widely presented also popular speech of Russian, common in the literature and in informal conversation. The entry includes interpretation of value, the characteristic of a structure of a word if it is multiple-valued, examples of the use in literary and informal conversation, data on compatibility, grammatic characteristics of a word.*
