Discourse

A complex unity of linguistic form, meaning and action, which could be best characterized by the concept of a communicative event or a communicative act (by T. A. van Dijk).

A special form of using language in current time, reflecting a certain type of social activity of a person (by E. S. Kubryakova).

Any end segment of speech that represents a certain unity in terms of content, transmitted with secondary communicative goals and having an organization corresponding to these goals, and also connected by other cultural factors than those that relate to the language itself (by R. Barth).

The Concept of Political Discourse

In a broad sense, it includes such forms of communication in which at least one of the components belongs to the sphere of politics: the subject, the addressee or the content of the message.

In a narrow sense, political discourse is a type of discourse which goal is to gain, maintain, and exercise political power.

The Pragmatic Approach


The characteristic of information in terms of its usefulness and suitability for solving a problem.

The pragmatic aspect determines the possibility of achieving the set goal using the received information.

The Problems of Pragmatics

is related to the fact that when addressing the subject of speech, the attention of researchers of speech communication is attracted

is related to the addressee of the speaker, that is, addressing the addressee puts the focus of attention



is related to the relationship between the addressee and the speaker, whose interest is attracted
