Christmas is an annual commemoration of the birth of Jesus Christ.

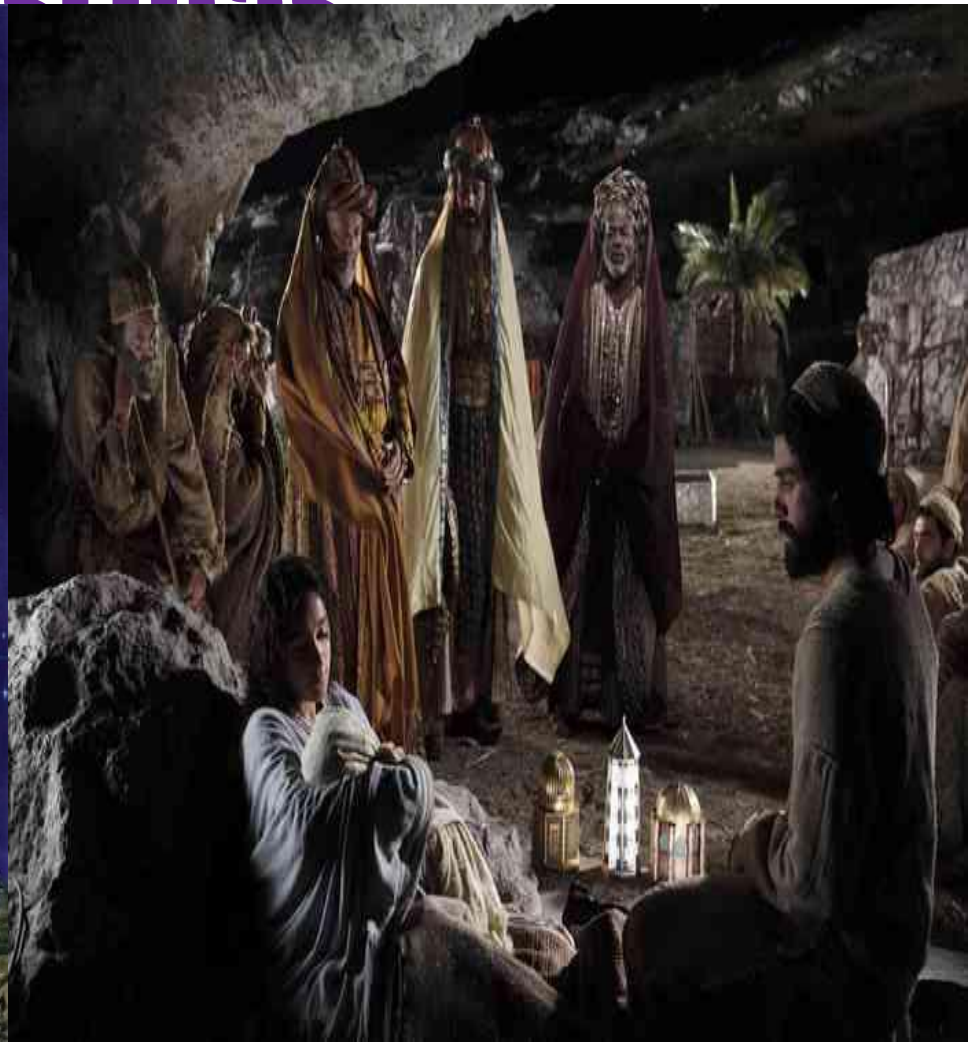


Christmas story comes from the Bible.
