King- the two crowns in one- white, red and gold- gold postiche- late period



Queen- wig- gold circlet with jewels- ribbons at back- 2636- 2633 B.C.



King in wig with striped linen cover- blue and yellow- false beard- 2780- 2762 B.C.



boy with shaven head- lock of youth- 1500- 1200 B.C.

boy with shaven head- braided lock of youth- 2160- 1788 B.C.

lady in wig- gold circlet with colored stones- white papyrus- lotus- orange ribbons- 2656- 2633 B.C.



girl with own hair in pigtails- 2160- 1788 B.C.

Princess in wig strung with gold beads- gold circlet- gold and enameled uraeus and rosettes- gold lappets- 1890- 1840 B.C.



King- blue and yellow striped linen headdress- gold postiche and insignia- 1590 B.C.

sacred serpent- goddess of Lower Egypt



wig of short spiral curls- 2560- 2420 B.C.
