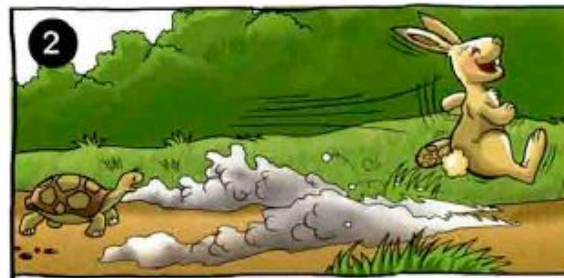

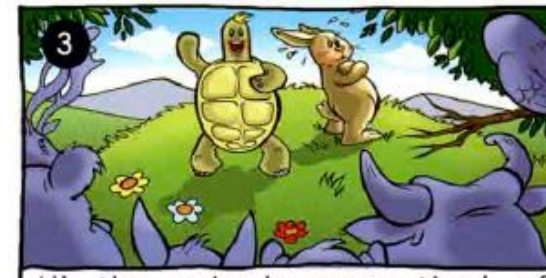

The hare always laughed at the tortoise because he was so slow.

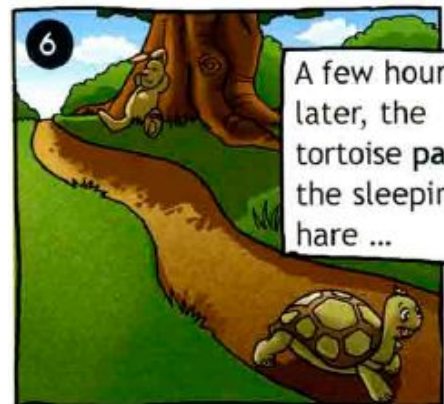

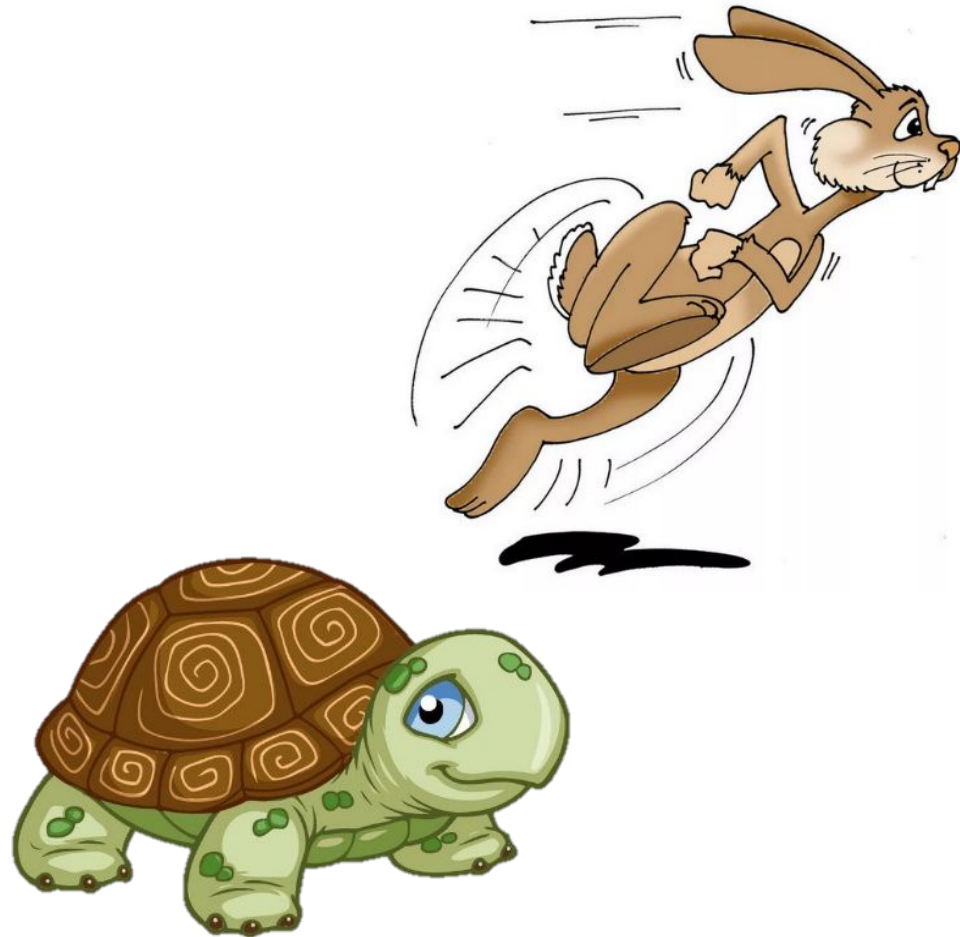
