# FUTURE PERFECT: ИСПОЛЬЗОВАНИЕ

- действие завершится в будущем к какому-то моменту.
- действие в будущем уже будет (еще не ) выполнено к какому-то моменту. Часто отмечается предлогом by – к.
- Часто используются маркеры: when - когда, after – после, by then – к тому времени, by the time – к тому времени как.

# FUTURE PERFECT VS FUTURE SIMPLE

## Future Perfect

- действие завершено к моменту в будущем.
- действие завершено.
- слова-маркеры: *after* – после, *by then* – к тому времени, *by the time* – к тому времени как

## Future Simple

- действие будет выполняться в будущем в какой-то момент.
- действие не завершено.
- слова-маркеры: *next week*, *next time*, *in ...*
