Past Simple vs Present Perfect






Past Simple. The action which happened at a stated time.

Действие происходит <u>в определенное время</u> в

Peter bought a new book <u>last week.</u>

(When? Last week)



<u>извертие</u>'s bought a lot of books.

(When? We don't know.)

Past Simple. The action started and finished in the past. Действие началось и закончилось в прошлом.

Olga had a cold two weeks ago.


(When? Two weeks ago. Now she feels good.)



Present Perfect. The action started in the past and still continuous. Действие началось в прошлом и все еще не законнивова a cold for these days.

(When? For these days. She is still ill.)
