The most common cause of acute bronchitis is a viral or bacterial infection, but other causes may include irritants like tobacco smoke, air pollution, or chemicals.



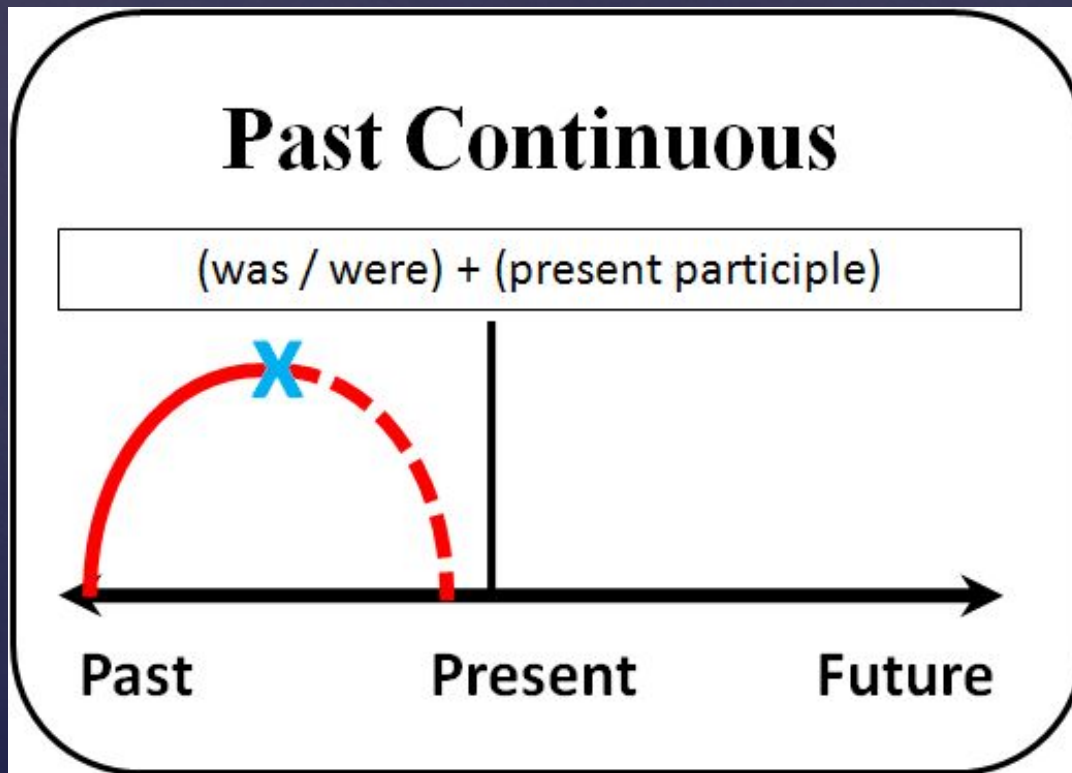
Symptoms of acute bronchitis are:

Used to describe actions still in progress (sometimes interrupted by another event), repeated actions (often annoying habits) in the past, used for background descriptions.



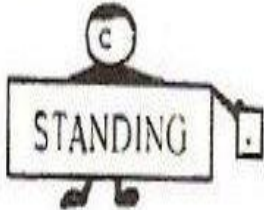
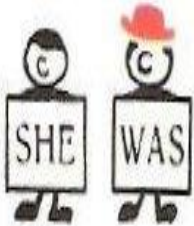


Used with:

We, You, They - were

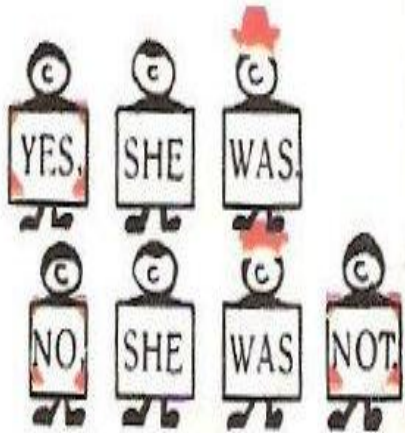
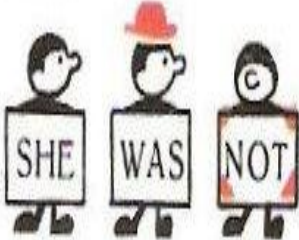
