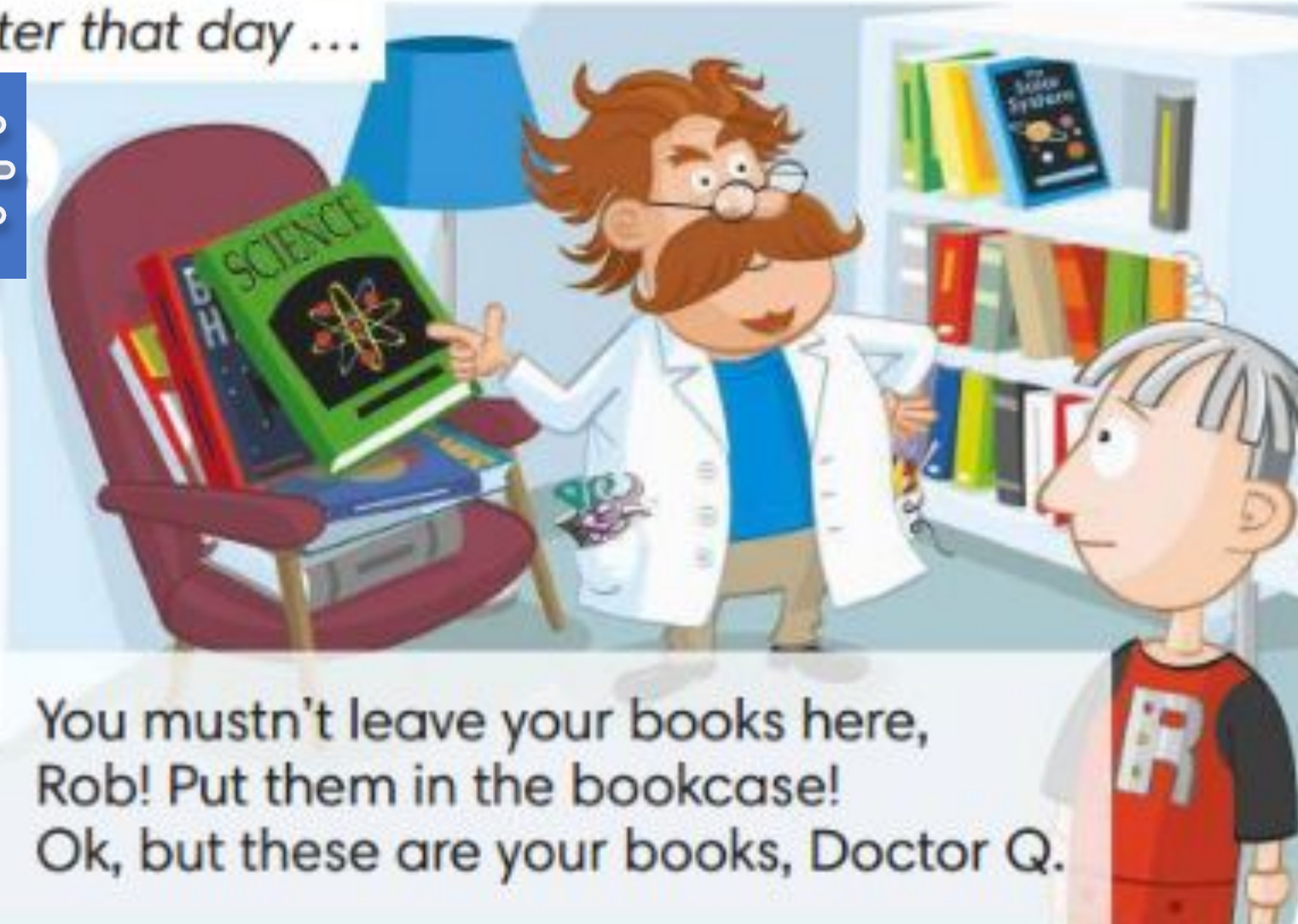

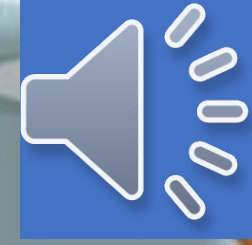

**Rob:** Ok, but these are your books, Doctor Q.

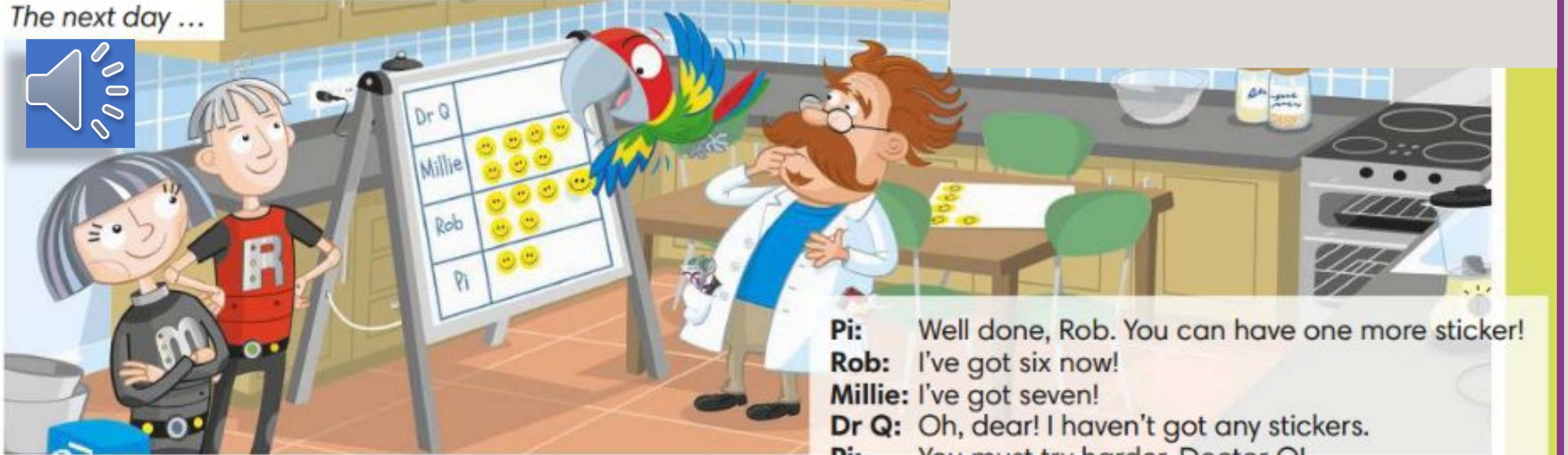


**Dr Q:** Millie, you can use my desk, but you mustn't make a mess! Here! You can keep your things in this drawer.

### *can*

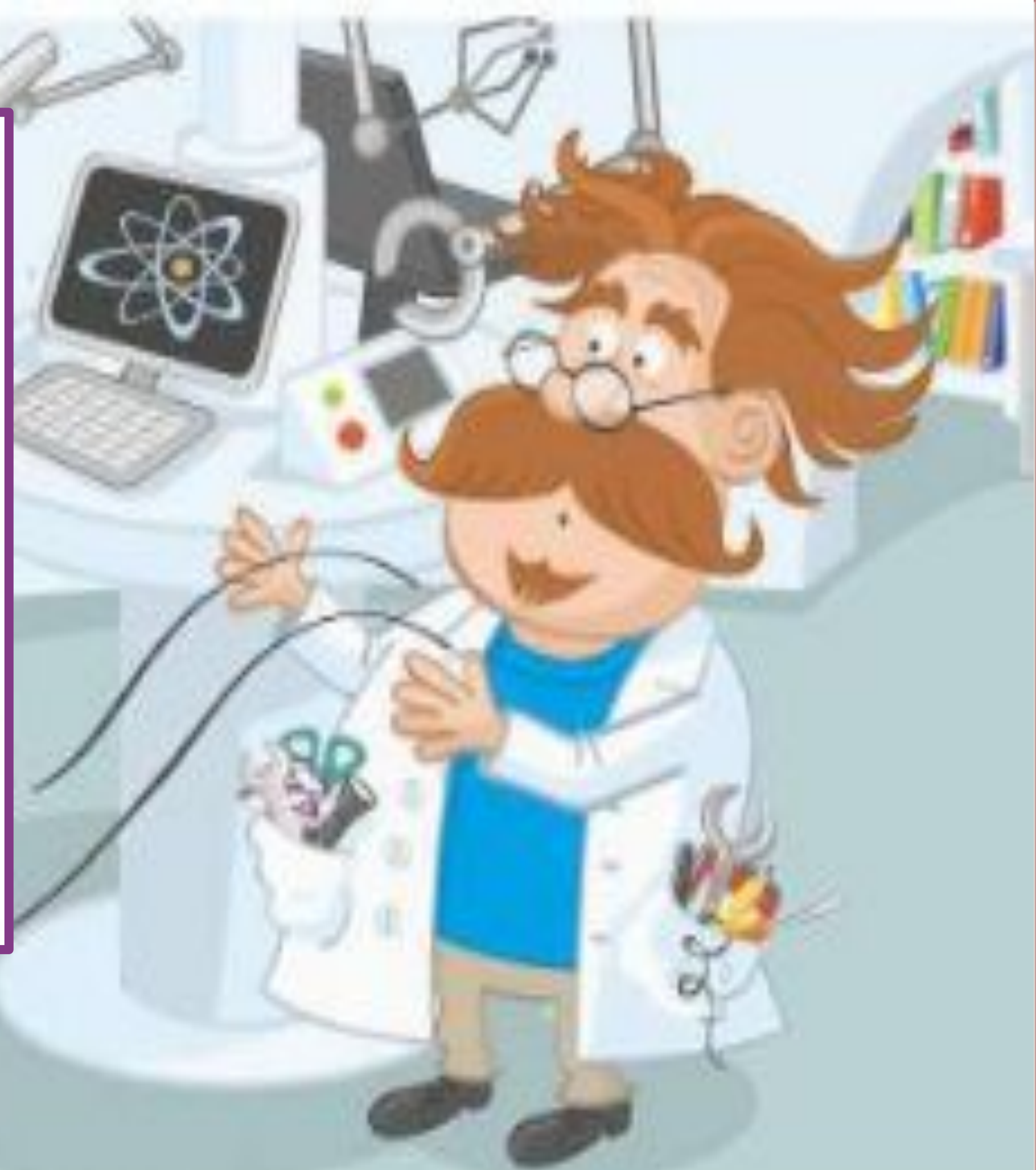
I/You/He/She/It **can** use my desk.

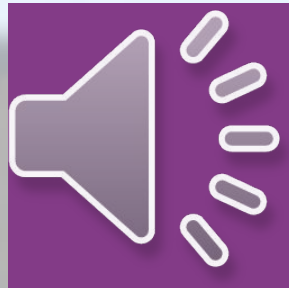
We/You/They **can** use my desk.
