## Affirmative

I/He/She/It **was** at the café.

We/You/They **were** at the bakery.

There **was** a shoe shop.

There **were** books.

## Negative

I/He/She/It **wasn't** at the shoe shop.

We/You/They **weren't** at the toy shop.

There **wasn't** a bakery.

There **weren't** any cafés.

## Interrogative

**Was** I/he/she/it at the café?

**Were** we/you/they at the bakery?

**Was** there a café?

**Were** there any cafés?

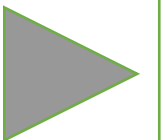
## Short answers

Yes, I/he/she/it **was**. No, I/he/she/it **wasn't**.

Yes, we/you/they **were**. No, we/you/they **weren't**.

Yes, there **was**. No, there **wasn't**.

Yes, there **were**. No, there **weren't**.
