My son played loud music yesterday.


"My son played music yesterday", she said.

We celebrated the New Year yesterday.


He said that they had celebrated the New Year the day before.

Everybody can | may celebrate the New Year.



That day / that night

She said that she would clean it that night.

That morning

The next day

She said that they would return the next day

The day before

The week before

She said that she was there the week before.

The following week

She said that she would return home the following week.

She said that she was drawing then.
