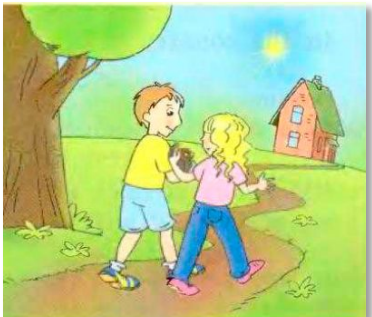

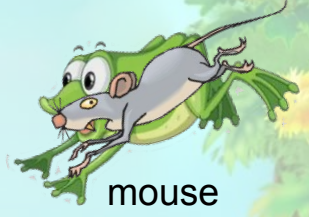

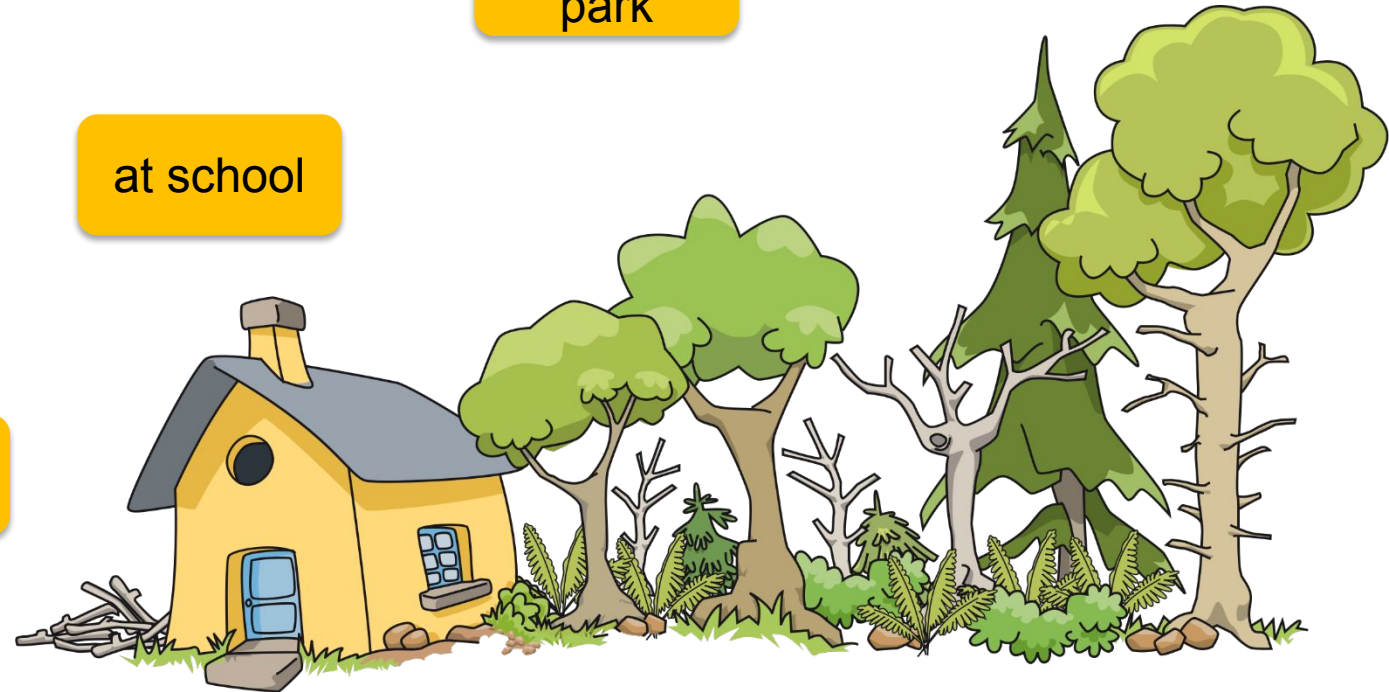

Форма вспомогательного глагола **do, does** изменяется и становится **did**. Порядок слов в вопросительном предложении остаётся прежним:



Did Tiny come to Russia last spring?

Yes, he did.

No, he did not (didn't).
