#### THE COST OF LIVING

The cost of living in Paris is quite high compared to many other places.

- This is mainly because housing prices are expensive due to limited space and many people wanting to live in the city.
- Renting a place in central Paris can be really expensive, making it tough for many people to find affordable homes.
- Other daily expenses like food, dining out, transportation, and entertainment can also be costly, adding to the overall expenses for residents.



## Summary of cost of living in Paris, France:

- A family of four estimated monthly costs are 3,266.2£ (3,811.2€) without rent (using our estimator).
- A single person estimated monthly costs are 914.0£ (1,066.5€) without rent.
- Paris is 9.1% less expensive than London (without rent, see our cost of living index).
- Rent in Paris is, on average, 41.0% lower than in London.
