





Если глагол оканчивается на глухой звук: /p/, /h/, /s/, /k/, /f/, /ts/, /s/, /ts/, /ts/






Если глагол оканчивается на звонкий или гласный звук, то окончание произносится звонко: /d/

smile - smiled
bake - baked
close - closed
live - lived
move - moved



Если глагол оканчивается на согласную, после которой стоит -Y, Y заменяется на Ги добавляется

copy - copied

cry - cried

try - tried

spy - spied

tidy - tidied



Если глагол оканчивается на одну согласную, перед которой стоит ударная гласная, то перед добавлением –ED последняя согласная удваивается.
