NON -ACTION VERBS: STATE

- ◆ A state is when something stays the same.



- ◆ Non-action verbs are normally not used in the continuous form

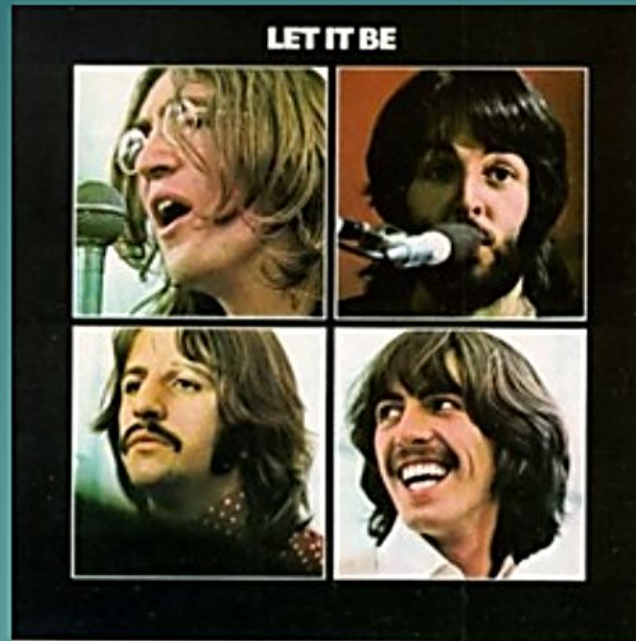

VERBS THAT CAN EXPRESS ACTION AND NON-ACTION

It is possible for some verbs to express state and action IF THEY HAVE TWO DIFFERENT MEANINGS



VERBS THAT CAN EXPRESS STATE AND ACTION

HAVE

Action:

"He's having a shower" (=taking)



State: "He has a house
in London"



VERBS THAT CAN EXPRESS STATE AND ACTION

THINK

“He thinks Obama will win the
next elections”
(opinion = state)
