



Kadnikov is an ancient town in the North of Russia. This place was first mentioned in 1492. The Moscow Metropolitan Zosima gave the donation certificate to Grigory Mochalov. He was granted the right to own Kadnikov wasteland in Vologda district.

The town of Kadnikov was founded in 1780. It got its name after the village Kadnikovo. At that time it was quite a significant settlement located on the

route to Arkhar.







In the XVI century, the trade route from Arkhangelsk to Moscow ran through the Kadnikov wasteland. That factor contributed to the revival and expansion of trade in the region and to the birth of entrepreneurship. None of those who were going to the capital or to the North passed Kadnikov.





Many famous historical figures stayed here. Among them are the names of such famous people as the founder of the Old believes Archpriest Avvakum (1664), Emperor Peter I (1694), one of the greatest Russian scientists - M.V. Lomonosov (1730).

Kadnikov is associated with the names of three Royal persons:







- On June 16, 1858 Tsar Alexander II passed through Kadnikov to Arkhangelsk. In honor of this event, the garden was laid in the city center.




- with the name of Tsar Peter I, who twice passed through the village of Kadnikovo from Arkhangelsk in 1693 and in 1694. He stayed here and had tea at a local place.



Its ancient name, derived from the name of wooden tubs (kadka) was immortalized on the approved coat of arms of the town. Cooperage and fishing were traditionally widely developed in these places. The kadka is full of resin that meant people sold a lot of it. The coat of arms of Kadnikov was approved on October 2, 1780.






Clergymen, merchants, tradesmen, servants, officials, artisans lived in the town at that time. Kadnikov developed particularly due to its merchants. They built a lot of houses that are still in a good condition now.



Famous people

No matter how small the town was, it gave the country a lot of talented people who showed themselves in the field of science and art: Vasiliy Krasov, a famous poet of the first half of the 19th century, Professor of the University of Warsaw, N. Andreev, the writer and theatrical figure Zubov Yu. M., Professor of Kazan University N. P. Sluginov











The main attractions of the

The chapel of Gregory Pel'chemskiy was built in 1879. It is very beautiful.










There is a Local History Museum. The Museum was opened in 1985 and existed on a voluntary basis. Since 1993, it has officially received the status of a museum. Its expositions were presented in 3 halls. The 1st hall - the history of the city, work and life of the population; the 2nd hall-military Kadnikov during the second world war, the 3rd hall — literary and musical living room. The Museum presented the auto lithography of the the USSR artist A.F.Pakhomov, an exhibition dedicated to the composer V. A. Gavrilin and the exhibition dedicated to Zubov's family. Now the museum is being reconstracted.
