SELF-PRESENTATION IS BASED ON ...

your ability to succeed, the extent to which you demonstrate your qualifications, your initiative, and your likelihood to succeed.

GOOD SELF-INTRODUCTORY SPEECH

- Stating your name clearly
- Placing yourself where you are from, the organization you belong to, the position you currently hold
- Background what can you share that is related to the group's core purpose for meeting? Is it an event, experience, a particular skill or educational qualification?

GOOD SELF-INTRODUCTORY SPEECH

- Interest, passion or goal what particularly interests you? What drives you? What is the personal goal you want to achieve within this group?
- Sharing personal details hobbies or pet peeves
- Unity what do you share in common with someone else in the group?

A SIMPLE SELF-INTRODUCTION SPEECH EXAMPLE

Hi everybody.

I'm Masie Smith, Senior Marketing Executive, from Watts and Frederick in Smalltown, Bigstate.

It's great to be finally here. I've been dreaming about the opportunity and possibilities of working collectively and directly with each other for a long time now. There've been hours put in balancing the schedules to make it happen.

Webinars and email are fine but nothing beats face to face.

Working like this has always been a passion. Even in kindergarten

- I tried to set up a group-think session around ten children problem.
- Years later my master degree focused on harnessing group energy creatively. I've been inspired by agencies that got it right.

Sally, you've already said it and I echo you. I'm excited!

"WALK ME THROUGH YOUR RESUME" (WMTYR)

Summarize your professional life since graduating from university

"TELL ME ABOUT YOURSELF" (TMAY)

Professionally, I...

- One macro sentence (# of years / functions / skills)
- One recent accomplishment or highlight such as being awarded company sponsorship or completing an important project

Personally, I...(list 2 to 3 interests)

- 1st hobby / interest (perhaps showing how you use your "mind" such as studying history, a science, or third language)
- 2nd hobby / interest (perhaps showing how you use your "body" such as sports)
- 3rd hobby / interest (perhaps showing how you use your "spirit" such as the arts, cultural activities)

NOTE:

- how articulate you are,
- how confident you are
- what type of impression you would make on the people with whom you came into contact on the job
- what you think is important.

Focus on what most interests the interviewer

 Highlight your most important accomplishments

• Be Brief

- "I can summarize who I am in three words." Grabs their attention immediately. Demonstrates your ability to be concise, creative and compelling.
- **"The quotation I live my life by is..."** Proves that personal development is an essential part of your growth plan. Also shows your ability to motivate yourself.
- "My personal philosophy is..." Companies hire athletes not shortstops. This line indicates your position as a thinker, not just an employee.
- "People who know me best say that I'm..." This response offers insight into your own level of self-awareness.
- "Well, I googled myself this morning, and here's what I found..." Tech-savvy, fun, cool people would say this. Unexpected and memorable.

- "My passion is..." People don't care what you do people care who you are. And what you're passionate about is who you are. Plus, passion unearths enthusiasm.
- "When I was seven years old, I always wanted to be..." An answer like this shows that you've been preparing for this job your whole life, not just the night before.
- "If Hollywood made a movie about my life, it would be called..." Engaging, interesting and entertaining.
- "Can I show you, instead of tell you?" Then, pull something out of your pocket that represents who you are. Who could resist this answer? Who could forget this answer?
- **"The compliment people give me most frequently is..."** Almost like a testimonial, this response also indicates self-awareness and openness to feedback.
