Hermitage



The State Hermitage (before 1917 - Imperial Hermitage) is the Russian State Museum of Fine and Decorative Applied Arts, one of the world's largest institutions of this kind.

Naval Museum



The Peter the Great Central Naval Museum is one of the oldest museums in Russia and one of the largest maritime museums in the world, located in Saint Petersburg, an object of marine historical and cultural heritage.

Alexandrinsky Theatre



Alexandrinsky Theatre (full official name - «National Drama Theatre of Russia (Alexandrinsky)», in colloquial - Alexandrinka, Pushkin Theatre) is one of the oldest drama theatres in Russia, preserved until our time.

Peter the Great Botanical Garden



The Peter the Great Botanical Garden (formerly the Imperial Botanical Garden, originally the Apothecary Garden) is one of the oldest botanical gardens in Russia, located on Apothecary Island in Saint Petersburg.

Summer garden



The garden is a park ensemble, a monument of garden art of the first third of the 18th century in the Central District of Saint Petersburg. The garden was laid by order of Peter I in 1704 and was originally regular. It occupies a separate island of the same name, washed by the rivers Neva, Fontanka, Moika and Lebyzhaya groove.

Erarta Museum



«Erasta» is a private and the first museum of modern art in Saint Petersburg on Vasilievsky Island. The name stands for «era of art» - «era of art».

Bridges of Saint Petersburg




In Saint Petersburg there are many (93 in total) rivers, arms, ducts and canals (total length approx. 300 km) and about 100 reservoirs (lakes, ponds, artificial reservoirs) over which the ok. 800 bridges (excluding bridges in industrial areas), including 218 pedestrian bridges.

Peterhof Palace and Park Ensemble



Peterhof (from Peterhof - «Peter's yard») is a palace and park ensemble on the southern shore of the Gulf of Finland. Located on the territory of the municipality Peterhof (from 1944 to 1997 - «Petrodvorets») in the Petrodyorets district of Saint Petersburg. The name «Peterhof road» came from it. Part of it is managed by the state museum-reserve «Peterhof».

Pavlovsk Nature Reserve Museum



The State Palace and Park Museum «Pavlovsk» is a palace and park ensemble of the late 18th early 19th centuries, located in Pavlovsk, a modern suburb of Saint Petersburg. The core of the complex is the Pavlovsky Palace, the summer residence of Emperor Paul I.

Lahta Center



«Lahta-center» (official name: «Lahta Center») is a public-business complex located in Laht (one of the historical districts in the west of the Primorsky District of Saint Petersburg), the building will be located headquarters «Gazprom».
